HOLD ON TO YOUR RECEIPT By Pastor Titus Lee

I John 5:13-15

These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God. 14) And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask anything according to his will, he heareth us: 15) And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.

What a privilege it is to "be in the know". When you're "in the know" that means that you're privy to facts that other people may not know. To know means to be certain of a thing. In the Apostle John's closing remarks in his first epistle he assured the church of the certainties of their faith. He said that because they believed on the Jesus Christ that they were to know that they had eternal life (I John 5:13), they were to know that their prayers were heard (I John 5:15a) and they were to know that their prayers would be answered (I John 5:15b).

We can use I John 5:13-15 as a premise to pray with confidence. Our confidence in prayer is predicated on us trusting God to do exactly what his word has promised that he will do. The operative phrase in this passage is, "if we ask anything according to his will, he heareth us." Therefore, our prayer requests should only reflect what the Word of God says about our situations and conditions. Our prayers should always be anchored in his promises.

Prayer can easily be likened to ordering a product by internet or phone. After the product has been purchased a receipt is provided. Once that receipt has been received it serves as an official record that confirms that the transaction has been completed. That receipt gives you full assurance of what was ordered and when you can expect to receive it. So it is when you pray, "believe that you have received it and you shall have it (Mark 11:23b)". Here are a few points that can help you pray with confidence and know that it (the answer) is already yours!

REALIZE THAT PRAYER IS A SPIRITUAL TRANSACTION

Prayer is a spiritual exchange. We give God our needs and he gives us his grace and strength. However, for prayer to be effectual it must be offered to God in faith. Faith is the currency of the Kingdom of God. It's equivalent to cash in our economy. When you pray in faith you are certain that God hears you and you are fully assured that he has already worked it out, even if you don't literally see or feel the answer. Whenever you petition God, intercede for others or decree the promises of the Word in faith it's like paying for the answer in full. It's your faith that releases the supernatural power of God to manifest!

GET A CONFIRMATION IN YOUR SPIRIT

Confirmation is assurance. It is when you know that it's done. Satan will try to plant seeds of unbelief in your mind in an effort to make you doubt what you've prayed for. However, resist all forms of unbelief and lay hold on the answer. Allow God to settle it in your inner-man. You will then experience unexplainable peace and unshakable confidence regarding the prayer matter. This is called a "confirmation in your spirit", when you know, that you know, that you know that it's settled in heaven and soon to manifest in the earth. All that is left to do then is to praise the Lord for the fullness of manifestation because it's already done!

EXPECT A SUPERNATURAL DELIVERY

When products are ordered obstacles and challenges can make delivery of the product difficult. So it is with prayer requests. Evil spirits (principalities and powers) endeavor to do all that they can in the unseen world to prevent your answer from becoming a reality! Daniel 10:12-13 says, "from the day that you set your heart to understand, and to humble yourself before your God your words were heard; and I have come because of your words. But the prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me twenty-one days". Satan does all that he can to delay and block answers to your prayers. Therefore I encourage you to speak to the atmosphere and command it to release your answers! Also, keep an attitude of expectation knowing that God is going to get your answers to you. Lastly, keep your heart free from things that can hinder prayers from manifesting such as: unforgiveness (Mark 11:25-26), unpaid vows (Ecclesiastes 5:1-6) and household bitterness (Colossians 3:19). Remember that it is already done! Get ready for supernatural answers to your prayers!

Keys to Doing Marriage









Congratulations to Pastor Titus and Nedra Lee on twenty years of marriage. They were united in marriage on October 28, 1995. One week later they embarked upon a mission of touching lives through itinerate evangelism and the Operation Link-Up Teen Mentoring Program. They have been blessed to serve in ministry as a couple for many years. Below they share 7 Keys on how to have a successful marriage while doing ministry together!

1. PROPER PERSPECTIVE

Your first ministry is to your house hold and then to the world. We have come to embrace that. Successful, sustained ministry is usually correlated with a healthy home. We know that our calling is to God, each other and then to ministry responsibilities. Therefore, we have chosen not to sacrifice our marriage and family on the altar of ministry "busy-ness" (business). Although we have given countless hours to serving in ministry it has never become a substitute or surrogate of our love. We realized that power in the pulpit is gifts (of the Spirit) oriented but power in the home is fruits (of the Spirit) oriented. God has helped us to keep the right perspective.

2. STAY BALANCED

Set aside time to connect with each other outside of doing or discussing ministry. If you fail to make time for each other "responsibilities and emergencies" will take your time. Therefore you must be intentional. Ministry is demanding so it's necessary to plan time for just the two of you. Just as it is important for ministry couples to pray together it is also important for them to play together. Do the things that renew, replenish and rekindle your passion on a regular basis. When a couple "recreates" outside of ministry it makes it easier for them to "re-create" in ministry.

3. BE ACCOUNTABLE

It's so important to assure your spouse that your perspective is correct when ministry assignments require that you be away from home. Maintain relational attachments by always being reachable by phone. Have a planned time to talk when you're away. Minimize extra nights away from home unless it is absolutely necessary (i.e., a speaking engagement or meeting the following day). If you're away in ministry and your assignment ends on a Sunday afternoon do your best to get on a flight that day to return home to your family (no matter how tired you are). Travelling ministers must always remember that when you're away from home your family misses you. Practicing accountability in this area has helped our love to remain strong through many busy seasons of ministry travels.

4. KEEP YOUR PACE

Don't try to keep up with others...stay in God's timing. He meticulously grooms and develops you as a ministry couple! Great callings require great seasons of preparation. Therefore, try to avoid the pressure that sometimes drives ministry couples to overextend themselves just to fit in. Never make "ministry status" your focus, keep your eyes on finishing well "as a couple". In your early stages the pace may seem slow but if you master the slow lane God can trust both of you to faithfully run in faster lanes (more responsibility). We have learned that as a ministry couple we must run faithfully at the pace that God has set for us!

5. BE WILLING TO SACRIFICE

We decided early on in our marriage that "our ministry assignment" was worth sacrificing for. Some visions and goals only manifested after we were willing to offer up what was precious to us. That has ranged from offering finances, properties, careers, conveniences and comforts, etc. for the vision that God gave us when were first married. However, it's because of those sacrifices that we don't take God's blessings for granted. There is seedtime and harvest for <u>every</u> couple in ministry. God never forgets your sacrifice. He will reward you and your children because you were willing to give it all for the call.

6. REALIZE THAT YOUR UNION HAS PURPOSE

We realized that we both had great purpose as individuals. However, God brought us together to fulfill an assignment that required our mutual commitment. Early on in our marriage we learned that each of us had significant roles to fulfill if we were to effectively work together as a team. We realized that we were called to compliment each other and not to compete with each other. We set (and still set) scheduled times of prayer and fasting together as couple. As a result of praying for our purpose (as a couple) we have experienced closeness between us and the courage to continue. Ministry couples should always remember that "two are better than one" and they have been brought together to excel as a team!

7. CELEBRATE SUCCESSES

Take the time to celebrate your ministry victories as a couple. Don't be so focused on moving to the next level that you don't rejoice over successes on your present level. Make a big deal over ministry milestones. Whether it's a soul goal, an acquisition, a first-time event or a successful outreach take the time to celebrate. Sometimes it takes months or even years to realize some "victories" so give yourselves permission to take a few hours or days to enjoy your progress and relish the moment as a couple. We believe this a great way that ministry couples can "encourage themselves" in the Lord!
