The Bible warns us to be careful to demonstrate love, mercy toward _____ for we just may be entertaining God's angels. Hebrew 13:2 *Don't neglect to show hospitality, because by doing this some have been hosts to angels without knowing it.*

Lot _____ toward Sodom because it was well flourished. Genesis 13:10 *Lot looked around and saw that the whole plain of the Jordan toward Zoar was well watered, like the garden of the LORD, like the land of Egypt.*

Lot settled _____ the city called Zoar which means small. Genesis 13:11,12 *So Lot chose for himself to settle in the whole plain of the Jordan and set out toward the east and the two men parted ways and Abram lived in the land of Canaan, while Lot lived among the cities of the plain and pitched his tents near Sodom.*

Lot eventually _____ into the city of Sodom. Genesis 14:12 *They also carried off Abram's nephew Lot and his possessions, since he was living in Sodom.*

The citizens of Sodom and Gomorrah were very _____ and practice _____. Genesis 13:13 *Now the people of Sodom were wicked and were sinning greatly against the LORD.* Genesis 19:4,5 *Before they went to bed, the men of the city of Sodom—everyone from the youngest to the oldest surrounded Lot house and called out to Lot, "Where are the men who arrived tonight? Bring them out to us so that we may have sex with them."*

Lot sitting at the gate indicates that he was a city official that did not participate with wickedness but was a judge against _____. 1 Peter 2:8 *(for that righteous man Lot, living among them day after day, was tormented in his righteous soul by the lawless deeds he saw and heard)*

God destroyed the cities and only Lot and his _____ daughters escaped. But his _____ looked back and turned into a pillar of _____. Genesis 19:25,26 *The LORD destroyed these cities, the entire valley, and everyone who lived in the cities died, and all the fertile land's vegetation.* ²⁶ *But Lot's wife looked back, she turned into a pillar of salt.*
