St. Albert the Great Catholic School registration for the 2021-2022 year is effective immediately. Enclosed is the new Re-registration online procedure and tuition schedule with the rates for the new school year. Registrations are taken on a 1st come – 1st served basis with current families taking priority. This past school year, we have had to place over 50 students on a waiting list. Don't delay your registration in order to secure your space for next year. Many families are opting into the in person instruction due to public schools in the area not offering full day in person instruction. Therefore we encourage you to reserve your seat!

Please note, there have been changes to registration fees, tuition, fees and mandatory fundraising requirements. Please review all materials carefully. Please note a change in Parish Member tuition rates. If you are a current registered Parishioner of St. Albert the Great Church the tuition rate will be kept the same as the 2019-2020 school year. If you are not a registered Parishioner of St. Albert the Great Church there is a 2% increase in the tuition rate. Please call the school office to learn more about parishioners responsibilities and how to register.

Registration for New Student

If you have another child you would like to enroll for the first time in our preschool program, kindergarten, or any other grade level for the new school year, please let us know so we can provide you with a new student procedure guideline. If you are registering a new student (sibling), you will receive a registration packet after you have submitted your re-registration. Please read the packet carefully and return the necessary forms and certificates to school as soon as possible to ensure placement for your child in the 2021-2022 school year. Please understand this registration does represent a commitment on your part.

Please note, the Empower Illinois Tax Credit Scholarship, Big Shoulders Fund Tax Credit Scholarship, and FACTS management applications are now open (https://schools.archchicago.org/tax-credit-scholarships). The Tax Credit Scholarship is a valuable resource in securing funds for Catholic school education. Families are encouraged to apply for these scholarships as soon as possible and reapply each year.

Required Documents

Medical, Dental, and/or Vision requirements needed for 2021-2022 school year:

- Preschool = medical
- Kindergarten = medical, dental, and vision
- 2nd grade = <u>dental</u>
- 6th grade = medical and dental; also proof of recent MCV (meningococcal conjugate vaccination)
- All new students = medical exam with immunizations
