Opening School Mass: On Friday, August 25th, we will hold our Opening School Year Mass at 8:30 am for grades K - 8 (our Preschoolers learn about going to Mass throughout the year, but it's a little too early for them to attend at this time). State Law requires that certain grade levels of school children receive medical, dental, and vision exams by September 21st. If your child has not completed their exam and brought in the paperwork from your doctor by September 21st, then they will not be allowed in school. The following grade levels must complete their exams: HEALTH: Preschool, Kindergarten, 6th, and new students - VISION: Kindergarten, any out of state student - DENTAL: Kindergarten, 2nd, 6th grades.
