Admissions application forms are being accepted as of January 27, 2019.
Enrollment preference is given to siblings of current St. Albert the Great students.

ADMISSIONS SCHEDULE

Below is a schedule of important dates in the Admissions Process for the 2019-2020 school year:

January 15, 2019	Tax Credit Scholarship applications open for Empower Illinois at 7pm
January 22, 2019	Tax Credit Scholarship applications open for the Big Shoulders Fund at 8am
January 27, 2019	Applications, Registration Fees, and Materials Fees for 2019-2020 school year are accepted
March 1, 2019	Materials Fee increases to the March amount
March 1, 2019	Application deadline for new students * Applications submitted after March 1, 2019 will be accepted based upon availability
April 1, 2019	Materials Fee increases to the April amount
April 1, 2019	Applications for financial aid through our online portal, FACTS Management are due
April 10, 2019	The GREAT Enrollment Race ends! Pizza party and dress down day for the winning room!
April 30, 2019	SATG Endowment and CARITAS Scholarship applications are due on the FACTS website
May 1, 2019	Material Fee increases to the May and final amount
August 1, 2019	All Materials Fees for the 19-20 school year are due by this time
September 20, 2019	Medical, Vision, Dental forms due to office to avoid exclusion

AGE REQUIREMENTS

- 3 year old Preschool students must be 3 on or before September 1st (birthdate 09/01/2016 or before).
- 4 year old Preschool students must be 4 on or before September 1st (birthdate 09/01/2015 or before).
- Kindergarten students must be 5 years old on or before September 1st (birthdate 09/01/2014 or before).

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS – *Prior to the first day of school*

(Medical, Vision, or Dental forms not handed in by September 20, 2019, will result in the student being excluded from school)

For **transfer students** in any grade, as well as new students coming out of state you must provide a copy of the student's most current medical, eye, and dental records. NEW exams may be required if coming from out of state.

NEW exams, as shown below, are required for all students entering the following grades:

PreK 3 & 4	Medical* (with the Lead Screening portion completed)
Kindergarten	Medical* (with Lead Screening portion completed), Vision/Eye, and Dental
Grade 2	Dental
Grade 6	Medical* and Dental

* Parent fills out and signs Health History Portion on side two of the medical form.
