Admissions application forms are being accepted as of January 1st, 2020. Enrollment preference is given to siblings of current St. Albert the Great students.

ADMISSIONS SCHEDULE

Below is a schedule of important dates in the Admissions Process for the 2020-2021 school year:

January 17, 2020	Applications, Registration Fees, and Materials Fees for 2020-2021 school year are accepted
March 2, 2020	Materials Fee increases to the March amount
March 2, 2020	Application deadline for new students

April 1, 2020	Materials Fee increases to the April amount
April 1, 2020	Applications for financial aid through our online portal, FACTS Management website are due
April 10, 2020	The GREAT Enrollment Race ends! Pizza party and dress down day for the winning room!
April 30, 2020	SATG Endowment and CARITAS Scholarship applications are due on the FACTS Management website
May 1, 2020	Material Fee increases to the May and final amount
August 3, 2020	All Materials Fees for the 20-21 school year are due

September 18, 2020	Medical, Vision, Dental forms due to office to avoid exclusion

AGE REQUIREMENTS

- 3 year old Preschool students must be 3 on or before September 1st (birthdate 09/01/2017 or before).
- 4 year old Preschool students must be 4 on or before September 1st (birthdate 09/01/2016 or before).
- Kindergarten students must be 5 years old on or before September 1st (birthdate 09/01/2015 or before).

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS – Prior to the first day of school

(Medical, Vision, or Dental forms not handed in by September 18, 2020, will result in the student being excluded from school)

For **transfer students** in any grade, as well as new students coming out of state. Parent must provide a copy of the student's most current medical, eye, and dental records.

NEW exams, as shown below, are required for all students entering the following grades:

PreK 3 & 4	Medical* (with the Lead Screening portion completed)
Kindergarten	Medical* (with Lead Screening portion completed), Vision/Eye, and Dental
Grade 2	Dental
Grade 6	Medical* and Dental

* Parent fills out and signs Health History Portion on side two of the medical form. This is mandatory. Exam documentation will not be accepted without this portion completed.
