## Welcome Class of 2022!

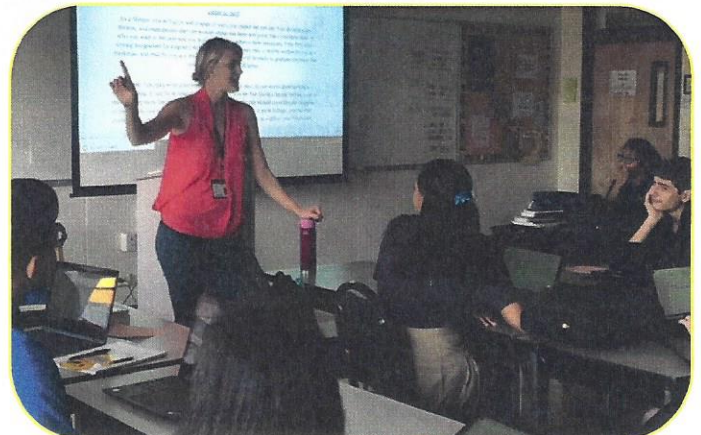

We are excited to announce that De La Salle now has a turf field for football, soccer, lacrosse, baseball and softball! It is incredible that so many of our student-athletes will be able to utilize this new field.

In addition to the new turf fields, the Parmer Activity Center underwent 10,000 square feet of additions. The additions were named Harrison Hall in honor of Carroll S. Harrison, Class of 1964, who designated De La Salle as the sole beneficiary of his estate. The additional space includes a cardio-fitness center, a yoga/dance studio, a multipurpose room, a wrestling room and coaches' offices.

Renovations also occurred on the first floor of the Parmer Activity Center to provide new men's and women's locker rooms, a training room, a laundry facility and storage space for equipment.
