
Calling all volunteers! WE NEED YOUR HELP! — We are not able to have all of the fun activities and successful fundraising events without the help of our families and we encourage you all to volunteer your time when needed. Volunteering shows our children the importance of helping out others; it is a great opportunity to meet other families and create great friendships and bonds and is the easiest way for you to know what is happening around the school. Our students love to see their family members at school events! Volunteer opportunities will be announced via e-mail when needed.

The Big Parent Pay Off Program – Would you like to volunteer your time? We appreciate your help and would like to thank you for volunteering by giving your child a dress down day! Each time you volunteer at an event, your child will receive a dress down day! (Your presence at non mandatory meetings like Parent Ambassadors and FSA will also earn your child an entry.) Dress down days will be every last Friday of the Month.

Box Tops Labels —Please help us raise money for our school by clipping box top labels and sending them in with your child. This is a simple and fun way for our school to earn money that will go towards fun events for our students. Each label is worth \$0.10 and helps our school to earn money!
