### Around the World with Trans World Radio

The ministry of Trans World Radio started in 1954 with a small radio station in Tangier, Morocco. Originally known as The Voice of Tangier, the ministry soon grew and moved to Monte Carlo, Monaco, and the name was changed to Trans World Radio (TWR). The Lord provided a radio station in Monte Carlo that was originally built by the Nazi Regime with the intent of broadcasting their propaganda across Europe. That station was originally meant for evil, but God used it for good (Genesis 50:20). TWR's reach quickly spread with additional large transmitters broadcasting the gospel into Africa, Asia, and South America (https://www.twr.org).

In May of 1984, Tom and I were commissioned as missionaries from Calvary Church to serve with TWR. Our first assignment was in Sri Lanka, an island off the coast of India. We arrived in Sri Lanka on June 4, 1984. I remember our first trip to the transmitter site and hearing the gospel preached in a language I could not understand, but I knew that on the other end, in India, radios were tuned to God's Word by people who did understand.

Living in a country during a civil war had its challenges. Tom oversaw ministry operations, making sure everything

ran smoothly, sometimes having to determine if it was safe to go to work that day due to terrorist activity and bomb threats. I served in the ministry department helping coordinate the translation and production of biblically sound Bible teaching programs from US Bible teachers into various Indian languages, thus extending their ministry. All the programs were translated and



produced in India by teams of Indian follow-up workers visited listeners. On one of his trips to India, Tom was able to attend a baptism in a river with 153 people lining up to be baptized. All had come to Jesus through hearing the gospel on the radio.

After eight years in Sri Lanka, TWR changed our assignment to another island, this one half-a-world away from Sri Lanka. Bonaire is a tiny island in the Caribbean, just north of Venezuela. From there the gospel is beamed into South America and the Caribbean. After five years in Bonaire, we moved to Miami, FL because it was easier for Tom to travel to South America from Miami's airport than from the tiny Bonaire airport with its limited flights. Three years later we moved to TWR's US headquarters in NC where I focused on the women's ministry. Now back in Baldwin, I am still involved with TWR, in their new strategic initiatives, through the technology of working remotely and attending meetings by Zoom. I recently joined in a TWR women's global prayer gathering by Zoom, joined by sisters in Christ from around the world.

Today TWR is more than a radio ministry, although radio is still the best way to reach into remote villages in many countries and the most effective means of getting the gospel into closed countries. Utilizing the internet, TWR360 (<a href="https://www.twr360.org">https://www.twr360.org</a>) makes available approximately 1,300 programs in 136 languages. TWR Motion, the video ministry of TWR, has produced an animated series of 20 Bible stories created to address the Islamic worldview with the truths of the Bible. Entitled Share the Story, the video has been produced in six languages so far (<a href="https://www.twrmotion.org/share-the-story/">https://www.twrmotion.org/share-the-story/</a>). A new series aimed at reaching Buddhists is being produced as well.

TWR's women's ministry and TWR Women of Hope (<a href="https://www.twrwomenofhope.org">https://www.twrwomenofhope.org</a>), is producing a new program, Precious & Beloved, to speak hope into the lives of Muslim women in particular, so that through evangelistic messages, they will know that they are loved and valued by God. English scripts are being written and prepared for translation.

Calvary has been a big part of our lives. It was where we grew in the Lord through the messages we heard and the study of God's Word. For almost 40 years, Calvary has supported us through prayer and financial giving to allow us to focus on the ministry to which God has called us. Thank you for continuing to play a part in the ministry through your support of my ongoing work with TWR.


