The Secret of Successful Leadership

Joshua 1:7-9

- ▶ **7 Always be strong and courageous**, and **always live by all of the law** I gave to my servant Moses, never turning from it—even ever so slightly—so **that you may succeed** wherever you go. ⁸ Let *the words from the book of the law* be always on your lips. Meditate on them day and night so that you may be careful to live by all that is written in it. If you do, as you make your way *through this world*, **you will prosper and always find success.**

Psalms 1:1-3

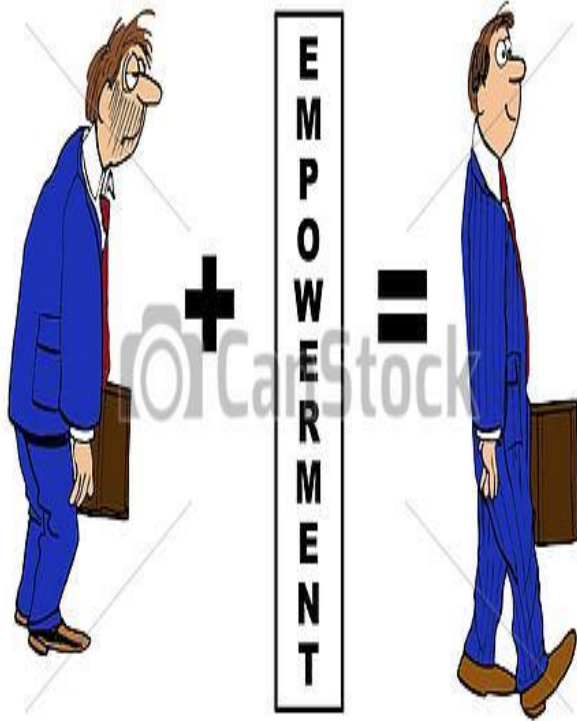

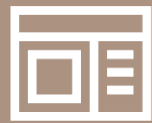
