



DATA NOTES:

- Value of free pregnancy tests = Number of pregnancy tests provided X \$9 (average cost for 1 pregnancy test)
- Free Ultrasounds = Number of ultrasounds performed X \$250 (average cost)
- Registered Nurse/Medical Sonographer hours = Number of Ultrasounds x mean hourly wage for Registered Nurses/Sonographers (May 2019 BLS data*)
- Consulting with New Clients = Number of New Clients x mean hourly wage for Social Workers in local/state govt. (May 2019 BLS data*)

- Clients complete, on average, 6 parenting education sessions and, on average, 5 after-abortion sessions in a support group
- This national estimate of savings does not include housing and other monetary assistance provided to some clients

- We can not quantify the value of emotional support given to the women we help through phone calls, emotional support and caring from over 22,000 volunteers
