

### **Resumption of Communion under Both Kinds**

"The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life." The term "Eucharist" originates from the Greek word eucharistica, meaning thanksgiving.

In the last article, I wrote about Jesus using bread and wine as both physical and spiritual nourishment for us. God's plan for us and our salvation is directed to our participation in the life of the Trinity, the communion of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Our sharing in this life begins with our Baptism, when by the power of the Holy Spirit, we are joined to Jesus, so we become adopted daughters and sons of God. This adoption is nourished through our participation in the Eucharist and strengthened in Confirmation. By our eating the Body and drinking the Blood of Jesus, we become united to the person of Jesus through his humanity, I am sure you are familiar with the Gospel accounts of the Last Supper Meal. Should you wish to re-read one or more of the Institution Narratives, here are the Gospel accounts: Matthew 26: 26-20, Mark 12: 22-26, Luke 22: 14-20, John 6: 22-59 (The Bread of Life Discourse). By eating the Body and drinking the Blood of Jesus in the Eucharist, we become united to the person of Jesus through his humanity. "Who ever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him." In being united with the humanity of Jesus the Christ, we are at the same time united to his divinity. We are transformed by being joined to the source of life.




