

What's Happening With the Three Parishes?

Many people have asked what's happening with the coming together of the three parishes, Holy Name, Holy Family and Our Lady of Sorrows. The process is called *Beacons of Light* and you can read about how the Archdiocese is structuring it at https://catholicaoc.org/beacons-of-light. Our grouping of parishes is called a Family of Parishes. At present, what is happening is all behind the scenes. The Archdiocese is finalizing the guiding documents that will help parishes work together as they seek to form their new Family of Parishes. The first visible steps will begin after July 1, 2022 when the new assignments of pastors become effective. That's when I will take over as pastor of Holy Family as well as continue as pastor of Holy Name and Our Lady of Sorrows. While it may seem things are lagging behind, they are really right on schedule.

We will need a way to refer to this new group of three parishes. C2 is what we are presently known as. Since this daunting task is a project for reconfiguring of the Church in this area, I would like to place our Family of Parishes under the name and patronage of Mary, Mother of the Church. We will need her strength and wisdom, and she already figures highly in the names of all the parishes, even Holy Name of Jesus, as there would be no Jesus without her. As long as there is no outcry against this name, I will ask the Archbishop to make it official.

In the beginning phase, Phase I, I will first be getting to know an entire staff, evaluate how the strengths of three staffs might benefit us all, and begin to form a new working atmosphere that encompasses three parishes. I will also begin the task of getting to know a whole new parish. I will beg the pardon of Holy Family parishioners as I do this. I am terrible at remembering names. To my eternal same, I will probably ask a dozen times for your name. It's nothing about you. It's totally my mental block. On the positive side, I am more likely to remember things that you've told me about you; what you do or enjoy doing, were you vacationed, things about your kids.

Sometime in mid-July, the Archdiocese will assign us a consultant who will help our parishes navigate the Archdiocesan guidelines and turn them into our own working process for reaching the goals the Archdiocese sets for the new Families of Parishes to reach. I am currently working to identify a team of persons made up of representatives from each parish to work with this consultant and formulate the process we will use to meet the Archdiocesan goals. Beginning in July, the three priests will begin a rotating schedule which will take each priests to each of the three parishes for at least one weekend a month. Please understand that there are already weddings, Baptisms and other special events scheduled that may force a variation in this plan, but eventually we will settle into a recognizable routine. Lastly, if you are not already doing so, please pray for our parishes, our parish staffs and for our priests. This will be a difficult, stressful and confusing time. Pray also that it will be a time filled with grace and many blessings. God will be with us. Mary, Mother of the Church, Pray for us.


