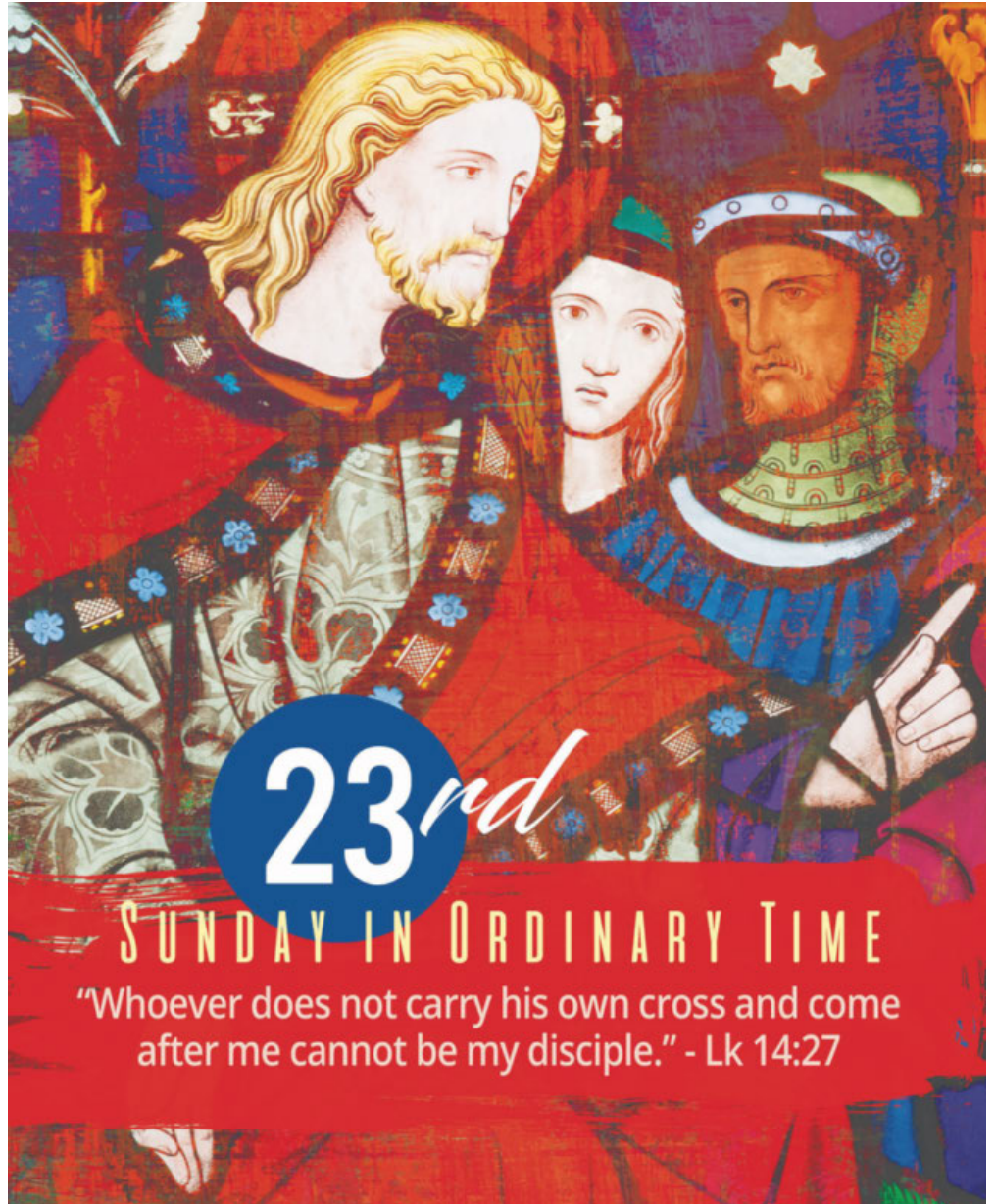

New Bible Study at OLOS



For 9 Thursdays - September 15 to November 10, Our Lady of Sorrows will offer a new **Bible Study called Lectio: Mary-The Bible & the Mother of God**. On Thursday, September 15, we will have an opening Mass at 6 pm in Church on the Memorial of Our Lady of Sorrows, followed by a potluck at 7 pm in the Parish Hall with a brief introduction to the study and a quick look at the participant workbook. In the following 8 video sessions, Dr. Brant Pitre examines what the Old and New Testaments, the life of Christ, and the early Church fathers reveal about the life and identity of Mary. Each of these one-hour sessions begins at 7 pm in the Parish Hall. This video study is a part of Lectio, a Catholic Bible study series from the Augustine Institute, creators of FORMED. FORMED is a digital streaming service that offers personal faith formation at your fingertips. Since our parish subscribes to FORMED, you are already a subscriber. If you miss a session, you can click on the FORMED link on the parish website to access this platform. Although Lectio: Mary is focused on Catholic doctrine and teaching, everyone - Catholic or non-Catholic - is welcome. In fact, we encourage you to invite friends to come with you. 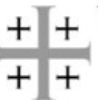
