

Family of Parish Planning Team Meets

On Tuesday September 6, 2022, the Family of Parishes Planning Team had its first meeting and all participants were in attendance. The purpose of this meeting was to allow the team members to meet each other and share their hopes and fears about this process. To sum up that part of the meeting, the conversation was by design, somewhat difficult to have, however, the members put a brave foot forward and talked about the real concerns that face our communities as we come together. There was a fair amount of discussion about the difficulties of bringing 3 communities together that are divided by miles of distance, we all agreed that this will be a great challenge. Other fears voiced were "losing something I built" which extends to anything a person has great emotional or personal investment in.

The Team also discussed hopes and even some possibilities for the future, most of them surrounding the things we fear. For example, making sure we honor those long-time parishioner families and the great contributions they have made to their parishes. There was discussion of making sure we don't lose those things that make us who we are as communities; sense of caring for each person and family, retaining a small-town feel even if we are a "large membership" church. And having events so that the peoples of the three parishes can get to know each other and begin the process of forming one community. All agreed that this isn't going to happen over night or even in a year, and certainly not by magic. It will take an intentional effort of we, the people of the parishes, deciding to work at making it happen. One day, by the grace of God, we will look around and realize it has happened.


