

For the Souls in Purgatory – Plenary Indulgence

A plenary indulgence, applicable only to the souls in purgatory, is granted each and every day from November 1st to November 8th, for those who devoutly visit a cemetery and there pray, if only mentally, for the departed. The indulgence is plenary each day from the 1st to the 8th of November; on other days of the year it is partial.

All Souls' Day (Nov. 2nd) – Plenary Indulgence

A plenary indulgence is granted the faithful who, on All Souls' Day, devoutly visits a church or an oratory and recites an Our Father and the Creed. Requirements for obtaining a plenary indulgence:

• Do the work while in a state of grace, receive Sacramental confession within 20 days of the work, receive Eucharistic communion (1 plenary indulgence per reception), have no attachments to sin (even venial sin) and to pray for the Pope's intentions (Our Father and Hail Mary or other appropriate prayer is sufficient)
