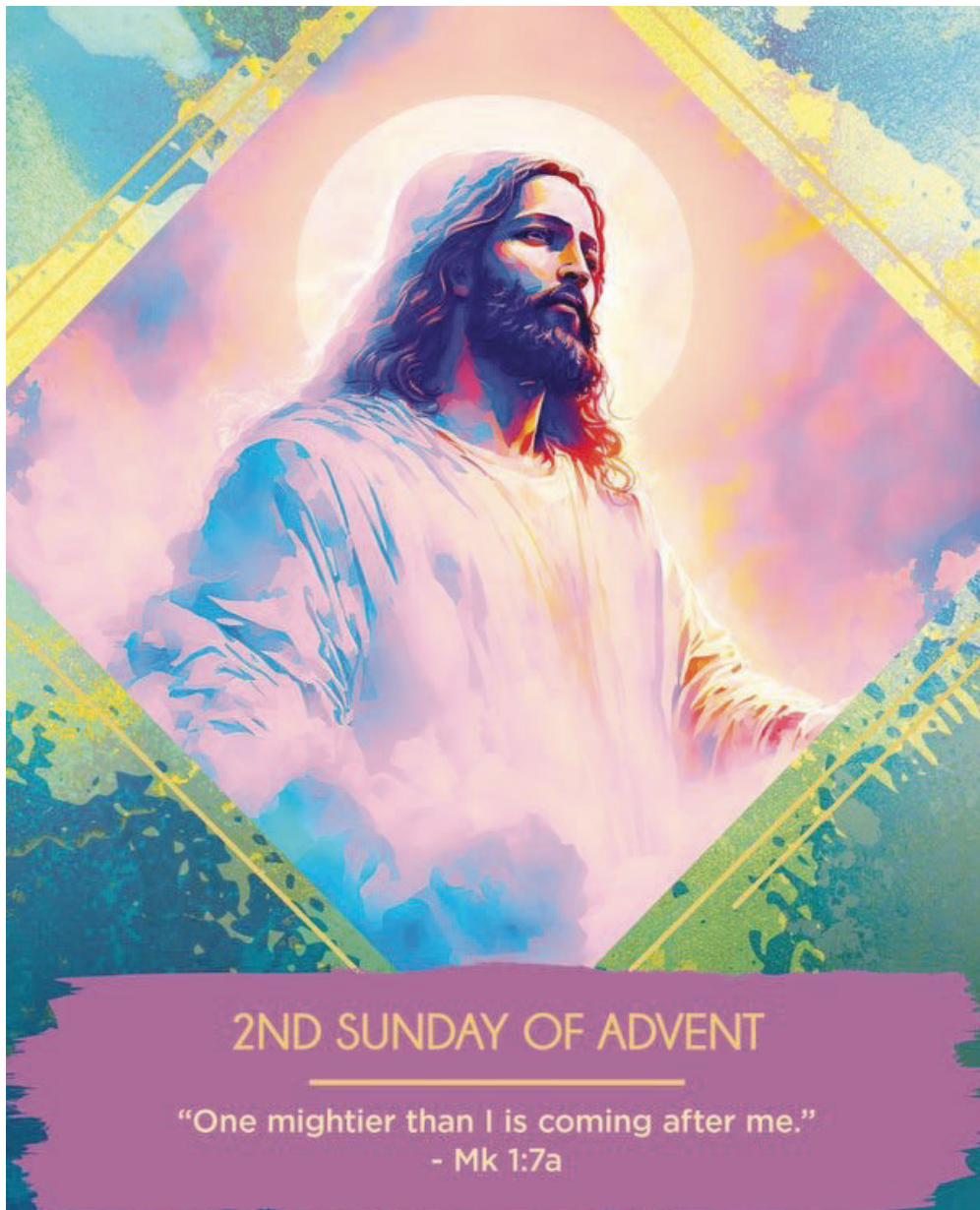

This "surplus" money is kept in interest bearing accounts, so we have it during years when we have big repairs or ongoing maintenance. Due to rising costs for maintenance and repairs we raised the budget (goal) for the building fund this fiscal year a modest amount. Please consider donating to the building fund. Even a one-time donation helps to ensure that we keep our buildings and grounds in good repair. When a large repair (such as the current water line replacement project) is needed, we are blessed that we have the reserves to complete the repair. **Thank you to those who have contributed to the building fund over the years!**

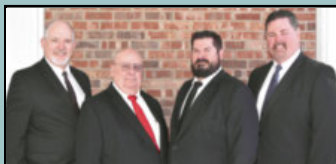
