Advent: Waiting in Joyful Hope! In many ways our life is a journey between two ports and two waters. We enter the port of this world through our birth and we depart it through our death. The waters of baptism initiate us into the journey of faith, and the rite of Christian burial -- which recalls the waters of Baptism -- marks its completion.

In between these two ports and these two waters, we live out the adventure of life. It is ours to discover from childhood and our teen years, whether our chosen vocation is to remain single, to marry and raise children, or possibly to enter Religious Life. Yes, it is ours to discover **our vocation** as a journey that takes us from a God of love to return to a God who embraces us at every moment of our journey until we return to him.

As Christians, we celebrate the birth of Jesus the Christ with a time of waiting we call *Advent*. Over the **four Sundays** before Christmas, we **capture both the longing and the hope** for the coming of **the Messiah** (our Savior). Advent is not **only** a time of preparation before Christmas. Advent is a time to cultivate a life style of **waiting** and learning to live in **hope** in a world that needs people of hope.

Advent calls us to **read** the Scriptures and reflect on people like John the Baptist, Isaiah, Elizabeth and, Zechariah and Mary, the mother of God. During this time of preparation, let us not get so caught up in the externals that we forget to allow the grace of God to call us to reflect where we live ... do we live between the waters of Baptism or a place of adventure, joy, and hope? Let us live each day given us regardless of our age, our physical, mental, or spiritual condition as women and men **with hope to bring to the world**. **Maranatha** "Come Lord Jesus and do not delay."
