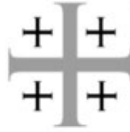

Building Fund....Did you know that Our Lady of Sorrows has a building fund that is used to pay for major repairs and maintenance? This "surplus" money is kept in interest bearing accounts, so we have it during years when we have big repairs or ongoing maintenance. 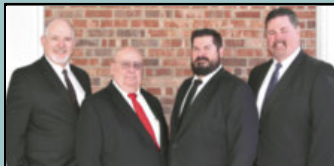

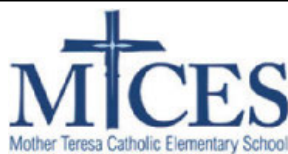
