First Reading - Jonah 3:1-5, 10

The Book of Jonah is only two pages long and tells a parable about a man called by God to preach repentance to the pagan city of Nineveh. Jonah's first response was to sail as fast as he could in the other direction. After his adventures with large fish, God called him a second time. Today's passage picks it up from there.

Second Reading - 1 Corinthians 7:29-31

In this section of the first letter to the Corinthians, Paul responds to written questions they had sent to him. Some questions had to do with how we, who believe in the next life, should relate to the things of this life. Paul expected that Jesus would return in glory soon, so he gives some advice which we hear in this reading.

St. John XXIII Catholic School represents 150 years of Catholic Education dedicated to encouraging and developing well-rounded, self-confident and compassionate children and young adults who lead successful, mindful, service-driven lives. Our school community is the foundation on which our core principles of faith and hard work bind us together as a family.

REGISTRATION OPENS TODAY

Registration for those in the Queen of Peace Family of Parishes and new to St. John XXIII Catholic School opens today. If you are looking for a change for your children, please consider our wonderful school!

We serve students from age three through grade eight. We offer half-day preschool with a full-day option (until 6pm). We have before and after school care for our students in grades kindergarten through eight. Students may be dropped off as early as 6:30 AM and picked up as late as 6:00 PM.

Students who need additional support through an IEP or 504 plan can receive this from one of our four intervention specialists, our speech pathologist, and/or our occupational therapist.

Starting in fourth grade, we offer a gifted and talented program for language arts and science. Advanced math courses begin in sixth grade and we are one of the only schools in the Archdiocese that allows students to leave eighth grade having high school credits in both Algebra I and Geometry.

ALL families are eligible for scholarship dollars through the State of Ohio EdChoice programs. The amount the state will provide for each student depends on the number of people in the student's family, as well as the families total yearly income. Winter Weather Reminder!

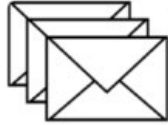

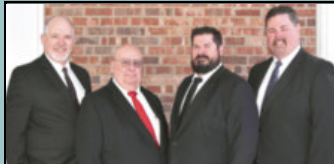
