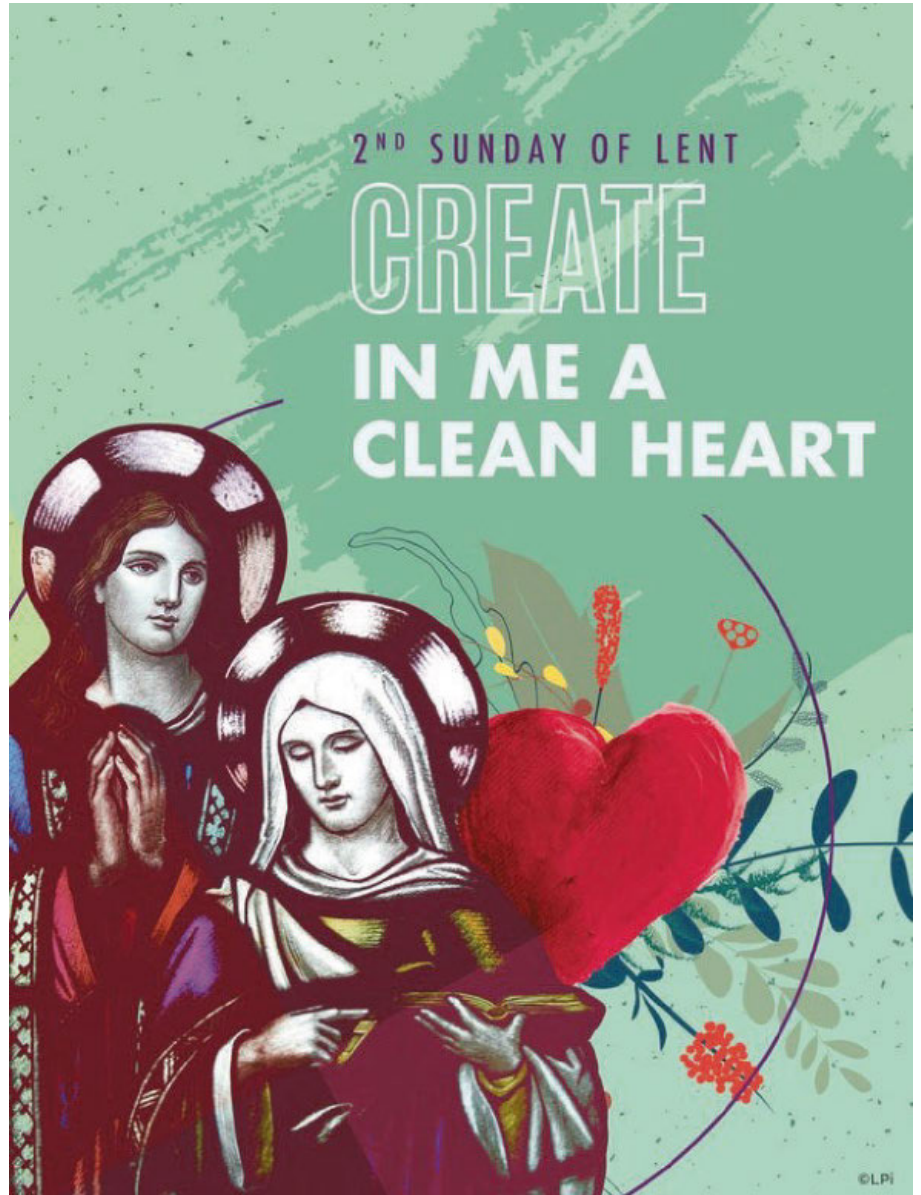

First Reading Genesis 22:1-2, 9a, 10-13, 15-18

Events in today's reading took place approximately 1800 years before Christ. In that pagan culture, child sacrifice was common. That's why Abraham believed God wanted him to sacrifice his only son Isaac. Later generations constantly looked back to this event as an example of Abraham's great faith.

Second Reading - Romans 8:31-34

Today's reading is part of a hymn that celebrates God's love and which concludes the eighth chapter of Paul's letter to the Romans. In our first reading, we heard how God spared Abraham's only son; in this passage we will hear how, out of love for us, God did *not* spare *his* only son.

Jackfruit Tuna Salad

SERVES: 6

PREP: 15

PREP: 10 min.

TOTAL: 10 MIN

Ingredients:

- 1 - 20-ounce can Young Green Jackfruit in brine, drained
- 1 - 15-ounce can Chickpeas, drained and rinsed
- 3 Stalks Celery, diced
- 1/3 Cup Grated Carrot
- 1/4 Cup Diced Red Onion
- 1/4 Cup Diced Dill Pickles (or no-sugar relish)
- 1/2 Cup Vegan Mayonnaise
- 1 Tablespoon White Miso
- 1 Tablespoon Whole Grain Mustard (or Dijon)
- 1 Tablespoon Chopped Fresh Parsley
- 1 Nori Strip, crumbled

To Serve: Sandwich Bread, Lettuce, Pickles, Sprouts

Instructions: Add the jackfruit to a food processor. Pulse several times to break down. Add the remaining ingredients and pulse again. Serve sandwich style with your favorite toppings like lettuce, pickles, and microgreen sprouts. *Enjoy!*
