## **Dear New Parents:**

The birth of a child is a major event in the life of any family. On behalf of Holy Name of Jesus we extend to you and your child our warmest welcome. Baptism is a welcoming of your child into the Body of Christ. You are the primary teachers of your child. Your child will learn about life, love, God, and religion from you. By your example and life, your child will learn about your values and beliefs.

A decision to have a child baptized is serious. This decision means that you are choosing to accept responsibility for your child's early faith development. Baptism is a beginning of one's life in the Family of God and is surely a most important step. To assist you we have established the following program.

- 1. You must be a registered parishioner in order to Baptize at our parish. If you are registered or attend another parish, you are required to obtain a letter of good standing from your Pastor and return to us before you can begin the process to Baptize your child.
- 2. Pick up Registration form or print it from the site Fill it out and return it to the Church office along with the child's birth certificate. This registers you to attend the mandatory Baptism Class. Although not mandatory it would be good for the godparents to also attend the class. You must register before you attend the class.
- 3. Selecting Godparents Godparents <u>must</u> be practicing Catholics who have received Baptism, First Communion Confirmation and be at least 16 years of age. If they are married, they <u>must</u> be married in the Catholic Church. If the Godparents are not married, but are a couple, they <u>must</u> be living a chase lifestyle. Godparents should attend the pre-baptismal class. Non-Catholics may not be godparents but may be an official witness as long as there is one Catholic godparent who fulfills the above requirements.
- 4. Setting the Baptism Date In order to set a date you must have turned in the completed registration form, birth certificate, and the class must have been attended by the parents. You will not be allowed to schedule a date until all is complete.
