

# All Events and Meetings at our Parishes Have Been Cancelled Until Further Notice

After consultation with the governor and health officials, the Bishops of Ohio are convinced of the need to take the following necessary action:

The Catholic bishops in the State of Ohio, in consultation with the governor and public health officials, have made the very painful decision to suspend the celebration of all public Masses throughout Ohio, at least through Holy Week and Easter. All public Masses/liturgies in the Archdiocese of Cincinnati have been suspended through April 12, 2020, and the faithful are dispensed from their obligation to attend Mass.

All meetings and gatherings are currently cancelled, as are Stations of the Cross, Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Benediction. The archdiocesan website will be live-streaming a daily Mass and weekend Mass from the Cathedral of St. Peter in Chains at www.catholiccincinnati.org. Daily Mass will be available online at 8 am. Monday through Saturday and Sunday Mass will be live-streamed at 11 am. You are also encouraged to continue the practice of faith by reading the scriptures of the day (found at www.usccb.org), and praying together as a family. There is a full list of health and safety precautions currently in place in the Archdiocese of Cincinnati at www.catholiccincinnati.org/worship.
