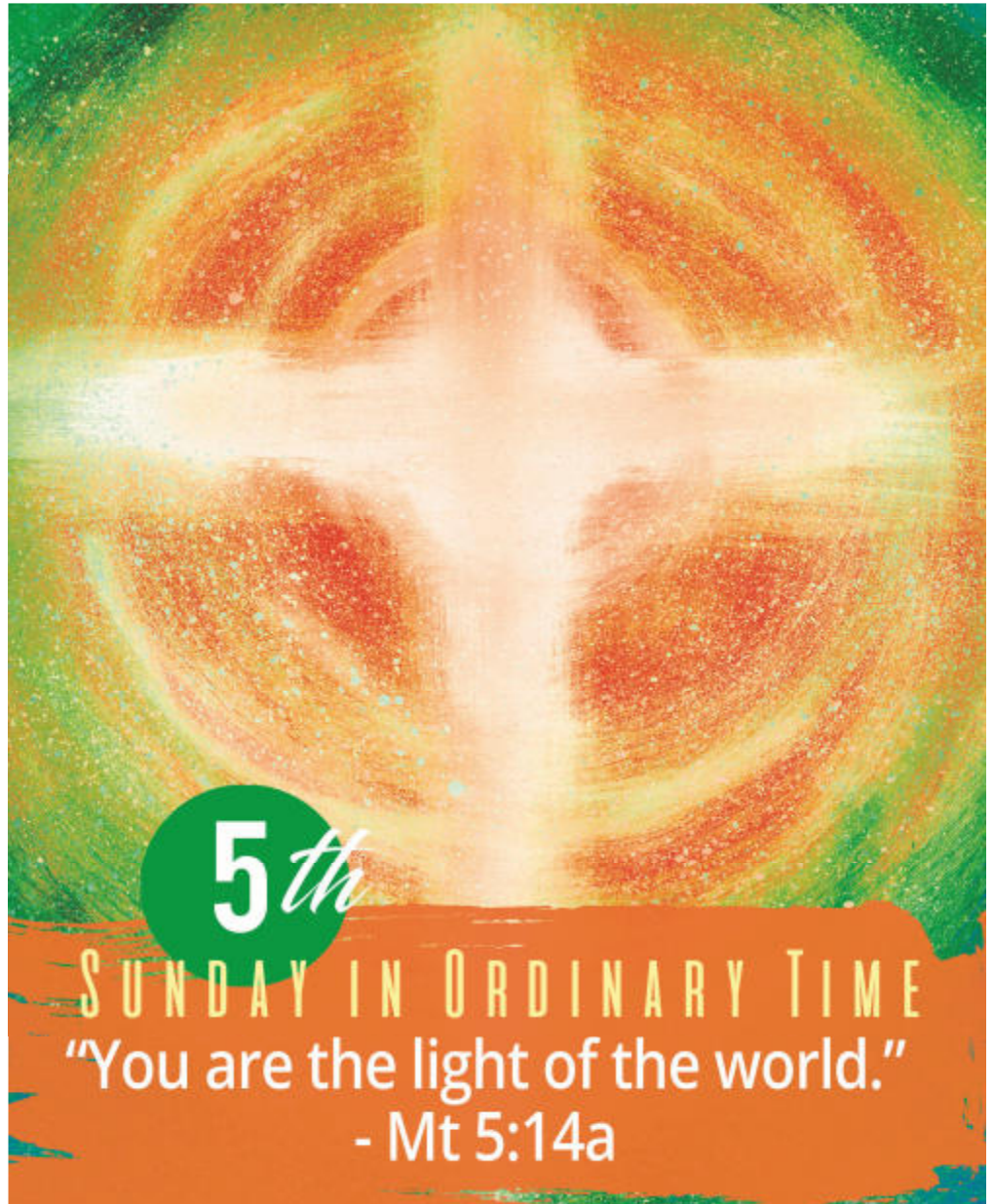

## Marriage Convalidation

*"Christ abundantly blesses the love that binds (married couples.) Through a special Sacrament, He enriches and strengthens those He has already consecrated by Holy Baptism that they may be faithful forever and assume all the responsibilities of married life."* (OCCM, #59)

Were you married in a civil ceremony or in a church that wasn't Catholic? Would you like to have your marriage recognized by the Catholic Church and blessed as a Sacrament? On Thursday, February 27 at 7 pm at Our Lady of Sorrows Church in the Meeting Room, Fr. Paul Gebhardt will discuss the process of having a marriage **Convalidated**, which is the Church's term for this process. Come and learn about this procedure and why it's so important to the life of the Christian Community. The benefits it brings to the couple, family, parish, and the whole Church will also be discussed. ## Become an *Unbound* Sponsor This Weekend

Pope Francis has called living out God's mercy "the beating heart of the Gospel." One way to answer that call is to walk with people in poverty and help them live with dignity through a sponsorship program. **Your parish Social Action Committee is hosting a sponsorship drive with *Unbound* this weekend, to offer you an opportunity to form a life-changing relationship with a child or elderly person in need.** Some of your fellow parishioners have been *Unbound* sponsors for decades and will be available to share with you how this mutual relationship of love and charity benefits all.

*Unbound*, formerly called the Christian Foundation for Children and Aging, was founded in 1981 by five ordinary lay Catholics. They sought to answer the Gospel call to put the needs of the poor and vulnerable first by connecting with the poor through personal relationships. Their humble effort grew into an international non-profit organization that helps children and the aging in 21 countries around the world through unique connections and partnerships, offering safer housing and medical support, education assistance and skills training to develop self-sufficiency for families in need.

Our Lord Jesus Christ, told us in Matthew 25:4-5 that what you do for the least among you, you do for me. To be His true disciples, we must live out the fundamental moral/social vision of Catholicism, often referred to as Catholic Social Justice or Catholic Social Teaching and the 4th principle of this teaching is *Preferential Option for the Poor*.

We invite you then to share in God's very special love for the poor. We encourage you to be open to the possibility that the Holy Spirit is calling you to become an *Unbound* sponsor, to embrace His son, Jesus, in the form of a smiling sponsored child. Perhaps this commitment could be a grateful response to all of God's gifts in your life, a personal form of stewardship or a Lenten "fast" that continues after Easter.
