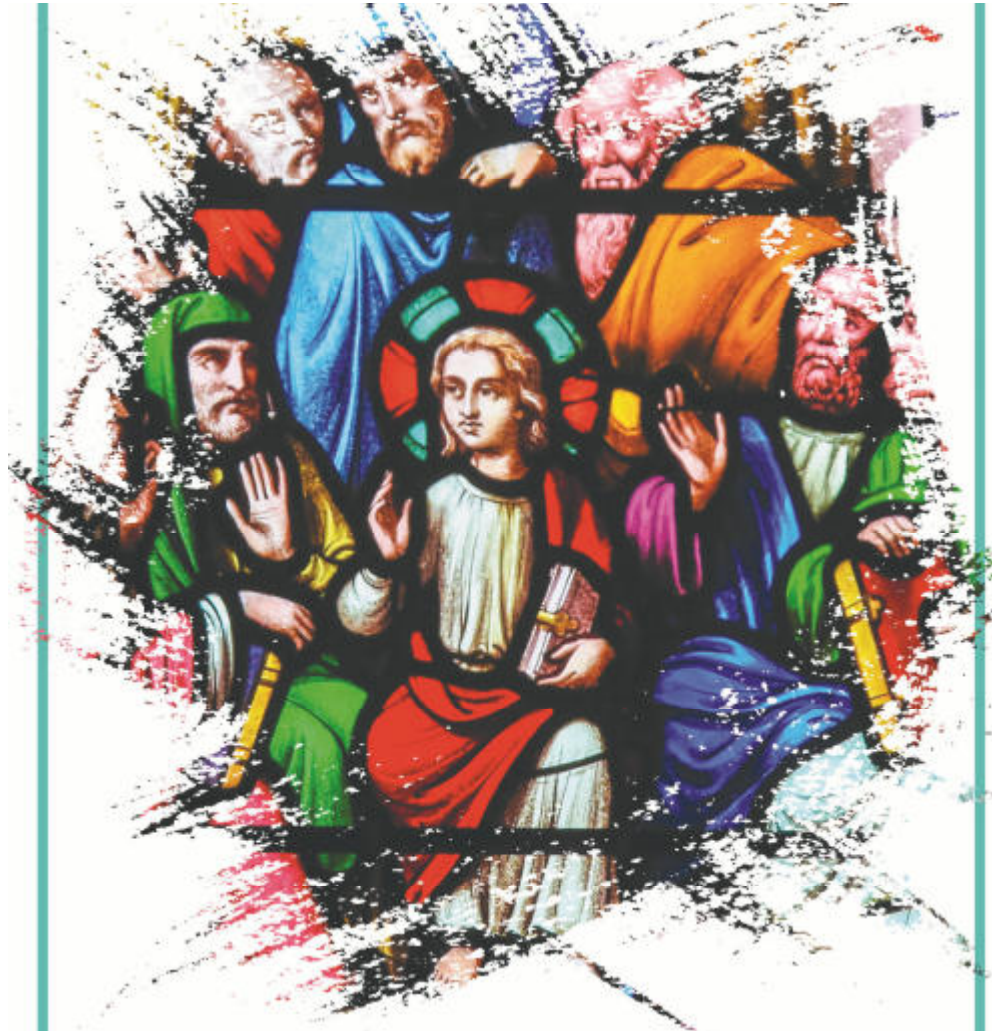

The faithful are still dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass. Those who wish to participate in Mass and receive Holy Communion can do so by attending a Mass any day of the week. Taking precautions, wearing a mask and being kind and patient during these difficult times are all acts of Christian charity. Those who are at risk or fearful that they or their family might become sick are encouraged to join us for a Mass that is live-streamed online each weekend. At each parish, we have been observing how to best comply with social distancing and health guidelines. We have been adjusting each week. We may have further changes as archdiocesan, state and federal guidelines are modified.

PSR and Confirmation Plans

While public Masses have resumed, it has come with provisions that this is not a "return to normal." Archbishop Schnurr has instructed that health and safety requirements must be followed. Therefore, faith formation offerings will look different and in-person classes for most of our youth will not be offered this year. This decision is based on many factors. We will be offering in-person classes for students preparing for sacraments, which will begin on Sunday September 20th. Parents may opt to prepare them at home. This decision will be re-evaluated throughout the school year. **Confirmation for our parish 8th graders is scheduled for Saturday, March 13, 2021 at St. Peter in Chains Cathedral Basilica. First Communion for our parish 2nd graders is scheduled for later in the Spring.** If your child is due to receive a sacrament in 2020-2021 school year, please contact Chris Baumgardner at 513-539-8061 or cd3.baum@gmail.com for further information regarding this process. For children in 1st, 3rd and 4th through 7th grades, the parish will provide weekly reflections and activities based on the Sunday readings. These activities are geared to all ages but some may need to be modified for younger and/or older students. More information about how materials will be distributed to each family will be coming.
