

BEACONS of LIGHT

The proposed Family of Parishes lists and maps will be available for public comment on October 1. These Families of Parishes will become a new parish under a single pastor within the next four years. "Parish" refers to a number of Catholics living in an area, pastored by a single priest. The parish may have multiple church buildings or campuses. The plan is that each Family of Parishes will have a single pastor and one or more parochial vicars (priest assistants) who may be either active or retired priests. The administrational and organizational model and details of the new parish will be planned by each Parish Family and all plans will be reviewed and given final approval by the Archbishop. All Catholics in the Archdiocese are encouraged to go to the Beacons of Light website to learn about the process and the Families of Parishes and offer their suggestions and comments at

catholicaoc.org/beacons-of-light.


