NOTE from Fr. Paul Gebhardt - A Few Words About the Resumption of Public Masses

May 15, 2020

Dear Parish Members of Holy Name of Jesus Church & Our Lady of Sorrows Church,

As I begin the process of applying the Archdiocesan Guidelines for Resumption of Public Masses to our situations at Holy Name of Jesus and Our Lady of Sorrows I want to share with you my perspective on what I believe the I and the parish staff are obligated to do and why. First, like you, I've heard the range of opinion about how seriously we should take the virus and all the media coverage of it. I've concluded that it doesn't matter. If there is any risk to the health of my parishioners from this virus, we must take the threat seriously and take all reasonable precautions to protect your

health and wellbeing. The personal opinions of the staff are of no consequence. Neither parish will become a hot spot for the outbreak of the virus if we have anything to say about it.

We do this for two reasons. One is already stated, your continued health and wellbeing. The other is your peace of mind. No matter what your opinion is about how serious the covid-19 crisis is, when you come to Mass you should feel that the church is the next safest place to your own home. You should be able to worship without undo fear for your health.

In order to accomplish these two purposes we will make certain adjustments which may include holding Masses in the HNOJ-Parish Hall/OLOS-PAC, using the HNOJ-Parish Hall/OLOS-PAC & HNOJ basement as overflow seating and livestreaming the Mass from the church and Communion being brought over. Or some creative combination depending on the numbers attending Masses. For the first few weeks we will set up our locations for social distancing and allow for the largest possible groups and then adjust based on what the first month or so looks like. Periodic adjustment will also occur as our society adjusts/returns more to normal, for example when/if school reopens in the fall.

Please, expect changes to the "normal" look and flow of church. Please watch for more developments. And please pray for your priests and parish staff. This is going to be a wild ride. - Fr, Paul


