

<u>Why</u>

Organized areas of ministry remind us that in the Body of Christ, we are many parts of the same body and as we strengthen on part of the Body, the whole Body is strengthened. As Christ is the Head of our Body, He will give us all we need to be fortified in all areas of ministry.

Below, are five areas of ministry that are either new at SUMC or would be stronger with additional folks working alongside those key leaders who have made a commitment to the ministry area –

Discipleship: includes small groups, training, visioning and spiritual growth

Hospitality: Let's add to the great ministry we already do: *Fellowship Café, Potluck, Sunday Greeters. Potentially, we could add: a Welcome Center table for guests; a follow-up of guests ministry; annual campus curb-appeal inventory.*

Altar/Sanctuary Guild: Cleaning the brass plates and candles; assist Cathy with straightening the pews after worship; sitting on the Worship Team (meets every 6 weeks).

Children's Ministry: Join the team to plan three events annually; teach the Child/Youth Protection Policy; Plan Sunday School; Create a strategy to reach children and their families; and more!


<u>Anti-Racism</u>: Two - Four representatives to work with the district and the conference in dealing with inequities, hate crimes, and misinformation. Also, to strengthen ties, promote peace and justice and communicate knowledge and wisdom.
