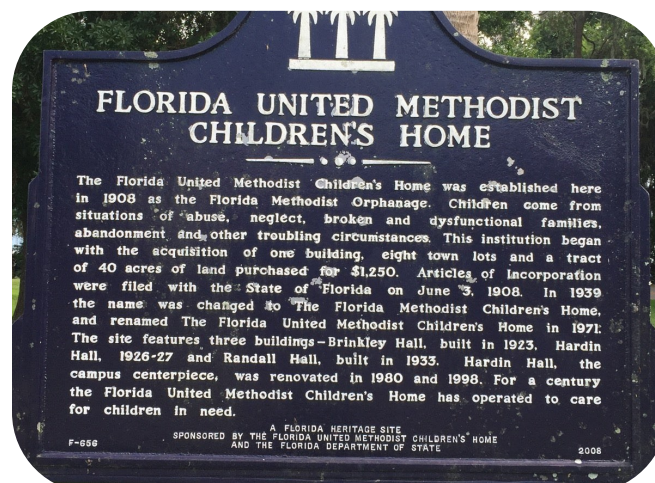
DAY ON CAMPUS
