A FEW FACTS ABOUT OUR TIME AT THE REGIONAL BISHOP'S EVENT:

- In attendance: Terry Chapin, Betty Hayes, Cathy Hinkle, Mary Jo Bray, Joanne Talbott and Pastor Alexis
- The Bishop moved us through a process of understanding the changes in the United Methodist Church postdisaffiliation by using examples of Orientation, Disorientation and Reorientation. For a detailed explanation, you can Google: Walter Brueggemann to read summaries of his book: Praying the Psalms.
- The importance of inviting people to worship, church and/or Jesus. We were invited to be intentional on a regular (weekly) bases.
- In the Florida Conference of the UM Church, we will reduce from 8 districts to 6 districts
- We have lost 35% of UM Churches in Florida due to disaffiliation. Which means that the Conference budget will be reduced by 35%. At Annual Conference 2023, the reductions began in anticipation of disaffiliation.
- The commitment of the Conference Finance Team is that the 35% reduction will not be passed to the local church in anyway.
- Apportionments will not go up for any local church due to disaffiliation or reduction of the Conference Budget.
- PRIORITIES of the Conference in making disciples: 1) Generating Fresh Expressions; 2) Anti-Racism Initiative; 3) Living out our Wesleyan roots; 4) Growing ministry in multicultural communities.
- Signs of Christian maturity in the church: Generosity, Grace and Forgiveness, and Taking Risks.

Music Minister Search Team Update

How blessed and grateful we are! In the last month we have had a talented Choir, musicians, and Tech Team that have blessed our services abundantly! We look forward to the Choir, and other special instrumental and vocal selections in February.

Although we have had several applicants for the permanent Music Minister position, there is only one who fulfills a number of areas on the job description for Full-Time Music Minister. We have widened our search to the states in the Southeastern parts of the country.

The process for this search is intentional. The resumes that come in must be accompanied by a musical recording from the applicant and three references. If the person fits the qualifications, Pastor Alexis makes an appointment to call that person. Following that conversation, she writes a summary to pass along to the Interview Team along with the recording and references. The Interview Team determines if this person should be interviewed, first by Zoom and then in person. The SPRC makes the final determination. The process from receiving the resume to a final determination after the in person interview would be a minimum of five weeks.

To date we have not secured an Interim Accompanist/Director. Should you know anyone willing to give four - eight Sundays, please contact Pastor Alexis or the church office. This person can play either the piano or the organ, and if they would be open to directing the choir, that would be an added blessing. In the meantime, Pastor Alexis is securing substitute accompanists for Sunday worship. We, too, are blessed to have an organ that will record service music.

Again, we are so appreciative and thankful for all of your support and prayers as we are God's hands and feet finding the Music Minister that He has chosen for us.

From the Financial Secretary

When we first switched to the plain white envelopes, there was confusion regarding the "need" for the envelopes or did you "want" the envelopes.

Envelopes have been a part of our church giving for many years and is a necessity to accurately keep track of all giving. All checks given must have an envelope made out for that check. If a member gives cash and wants it recorded under their name for end of year statements an envelope must also be made for that amount of cash.

The envelopes provided by the church have your name and your computer number typed on the face of the envelope. This number provides the needed information to post the givings to your account. This is also a tremendous help for the financial team to complete the job of keeping track of all money in a safe, accurate, efficient and helpful way.

Some might say, "I use a pew envelope" which is fine but not as good as your own envelope with your name and number on it. Reading the writing on the pew envelopes have proven in the past to be a challenge.

Alta Benjamin communicated the above in Dec. 2018 and it is just as important now.

If you don't use numbered envelopes, please request them from the office and use them every time. Children's Home envelopes are an exception.
