Worship Modifications Begin on January 17

As we continue to ease back to “normalcy,” we are gradually making modifications to our worship options, while remaining safe and COVID-compliant. **Beginning Sunday, January 17,** our options for worship will shift, as follows:

9:00 a.m. In-person worship will move from the Fellowship Hall to the Sanctuary.

9:00 a.m. Virtual worship on Facebook: The 9:00 a.m. In-person service will be streamed live (no longer “live” at 10 a.m., but available for viewing at 10 a.m. or any time following).

11:00 a.m. In-person worship in the Sanctuary (moving earlier by 15 minutes).

Note: The order of worship will be slightly modified to allow for more singing, all towards to end of the services to keep the risk of COVID transmission as low as possible. Masks and social distancing are still required, of course.

This change (again, beginning January 17) will allow for all worship options to be identical. We will return to celebrating communion once a month across all services. All services will sing two hymns, the doxology and congregational response. This will be accomplished by moving the opening hymn to the offering. For those who have been attending virtually, the amount of singing will not change. It will happen at different times in the service.

We are excited to be able to begin holding all our in-person services in the sanctuary. We anticipate this to be our “new normal” until the pandemic passes. Thank you for your understanding and flexibility.
