SUMC MUSIC MINISTER SEARCH TEAM UPDATE:

The Search Team is made up of eleven individuals from our congregation, including: Choir members, Staff/Pastor Parish members, the Worship Committee and Pastor. We have met three times since November to update the permanent full time job description; an interim job description while we seek a full-time person; and, establish a hiring team for transition time and full-time applicants. Our intent is to continue to send job descriptions to the American Guild of Organists, higher education institutions, music schools and departments in Florida, Georgia, Alabama, and Texas, and other pertinent places where potential music ministers may be.

We are grateful for Sharon Krueger, the Chairperson of the Search Committee. And, very grateful for our Chancel Choir who will continue to lead us in hymns and special music in this interim. Please hug or thank a choir member on any Sunday for their continued support.

While we are looking for an interim and/or full-time permanent Music Minister, we are scheduling Sunday substitutes.
