Happy Lent, SUMC friends and family!

For years now when people have asked me, "What is your favorite High Holy Day?" Of course, Advent, Christmas and Easter each are cherished in my heart and my mind! What do you "wish" you do less of; and, stand firm in Christ's love, His sacrifice and how He adores you. Will you join me in complaining less about what could be and praising God more for what God has done, is doing, and is about to do!

To assist you in this endeavor, if you choose to practice the Lenten Discipline with me, each Sunday in Lent, I will offer to you a way to live out your faith and grow in relationship with God using a spiritual discipline as a tool (If you missed the first Sundays in Lent, no worries. Team Up for New Ministries

Pray: About where God is calling you in ministry. Pray, too, for those who are yet to enter our doors and reap the joy of God's blessing!

Goal: For the ministries in the spring.

<u>Why</u>: Organized areas of ministry remind us that in the Body of Christ, we are many parts of the same body and as we strengthen on part of the Body, the whole Body is strengthened. As Christ is the Head of our Body, He will give us all we need to be fortified in all areas of ministry.

Below, are five areas of ministry that are either new in this season at SUMC or would be stronger with additional folks. Within each area, key people working to ensure that each ministry stays vital, adding to that ministry would only make us a stronger body.

Discipleship: Includes small groups, training, events, visioning and spiritual growth

<u>Hospitality</u>: The Great ministry we already do: Fellowship Café, Pot Luck, Sunday Greeters. What we could add: a Welcome Center table for guests; follow-up guests ministry team; annual campus curb-appeal inventory.

<u>Altar/Sanctuary Guild</u>: Cleaning the brass plates and candles; assist with straightening the pews after worship; sit on the Worship Team (meets approximately every 6 weeks).

<u>Children's Ministry</u>: Plan three events annually; teach the Child/Youth Protection Policy; Plan Sunday School; Create a strategy to reach children and their families; and more!

<u>Anti-Racism</u>: Two - four representatives to work with the district and the conference in dealing with inequities, hate crimes, and misinformation. Also, to strengthen ties, promote peace and justice and communicate knowledge and wisdom.
