The Salvation Army is going through an internal staffing change in May and June, that affects the people we depend on to deliver our food supplies. To continue to have this mission, feeding those in need, we need temporary volunteer help.

Salvation Army would still be able to place our orders for supplies, but they will not have a person that is able to deliver our supplies to SUMC weekly from their location in south Vero.

I have been told by Captain Amber that once they are able to hire a new person they would once again deliver food to us.

We need to make a choice:

- We can *temporarily* stop providing the meals as of May 9th, until The Salvation Army can once again bring the food to us.
- We can go to Vero to pick up the food & bring it here.

All Soul Café volunteers are being asked to see if any of them or someone they may know would take on this function. Likewise, I am asking all who read this to consider getting the food each week or letting me know if you know of someone who would want to take this on.

Transfer of membership from another Christian church or denomination – We welcome you to our church upon your statement.

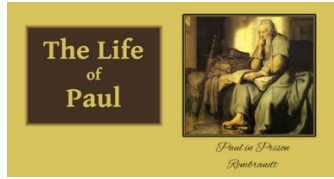

Three times I was beaten with rods, once I was pelted with stones, three times I was shipwrecked, I spent a night and a day in the open sea, I have been constantly on the move. I have been in danger from rivers, in danger from bandits, in danger from my fellow Jews, in danger from Gentiles; in danger in the city, in danger in the country, in danger at sea; and in danger from false believers. I have labored and toiled and have often gone without sleep; I have known hunger and thirst and have often gone without food; I have been cold and naked.

II Corinthians 11:25-27

Paul traveled over 10,000 miles proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus Christ. His journeys on land and sea took him through present day Israel, Syria, Turkey and Greece. Paul walked the roads build by the Romans. On them, there was a constant danger of bandits. In order to understand and appreciate Paul's life and to more deeply understand how he took Christianity to the nations; we will spend the month of May through June 21st traveling with him on his journeys, stopping along the way at the congregations he established.
