# March Mission Projects

Two great projects to support this month



## ***Project 1 – reStart :***

For 40 years, reStart has operated to assist the homeless. In years past, LLCUMC has volunteered at the “soup kitchen”, but reStart has expanded its services greatly. Today reStart provides emergency shelter, transitional living, and permanent housing support to individuals and families in Kansas City, including people with mental illnesses or the chronically disabled. They have the emergency shelter facility that we are familiar with, and also operate in 11 other locations, including 72 apartment units for singles and families.

For our March service project, LLCUMC will prepare 60 sack lunches to deliver to reStart on March 31 for individuals in transitional living to take to their jobs. By March 21<sup>st</sup>, we need everyone to help provide the food for these sack lunches (extra food will be donated to reStart):

**Four 18 oz jars peanut butter**

**Individually wrapped beef jerky**

**Granola bars**

**Individually wrapped snacks**

**Individual fruit cups/applesauce cups**

**Bottled water (60 bottles total)**

**60 paper lunch sacks**

His podcast, called the RobCast, was named by iTunes Best of 2015. He's been profiled in the New Yorker and Time Magazine named him one of the 100 Most Influential People in the World in 2011.
