

## **HOLY WEEK SERVICES**

This is a special time in the Christian calendar as we anticipate the services of Holy Week—the week between Palm Sunday and Easter Sunday. We want to provide you and your family several opportunities to mark this time of year in worship of our Lord and Savior here at LLCUMC.

**Palm Sunday Services**, March 28, 2021, 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m.

Maundy Thursday Service of Holy Communion and Darkness, April 1, 2021, 7:00 p.m.

This will be a special service in which we will remember the Last Supper of Jesus with his disciples and the events that unfolded after they left that upper room that night and into the next day—what the Church calls Good Friday. We will need at least 3 volunteers to be readers of Christ's Passion during this service, so let Pastor Tom know if you would like to participate in this special service. Pastor Tom is planning a meaningful way to celebrate Holy Communion using real bread and one cup using the method of intinction.

## Easter Sunrise Service, April 4, 2021, 7:00 a.m.

Our sunrise service will be a simple gathering of the faithful—members, families, friends, neighbors—who want to start this special day in the Christian year in what has become a tradition for many. We will attempt to have this year's sunrise service at the memorial garden just down the street as we've had in the past. We will need some help getting some items down to the garden, so we are looking for a volunteer with a pick-up truck. We will <u>not</u> have our usual service at 8:00 a.m. on Easter in lieu of the sunrise service. **No decision has been made on whether or not we will have a continental breakfast at the church after the sunrise service**, so we will let you know as soon as that decision has been made. If it is raining, we will have the service in our sanctuary at 7:00 a.m.

## **Easter Sunday Service of Holy Communion**, April 4, 2021, 10:00 a.m.

We will celebrate Christ's victory over death and the eternal consequence the first Easter has for us as modern Christians on this special day. It will be preceded by our Christian education classes for children and adults at 9:00 a.m. We will observe current COVID protocols, and since all the pews will be available to use, we will distance ourselves as family units to the best of our ability. The foyer will serve as our overflow area should it be needed. Pastor Tom will again use the same method of distributing the elements of Holy Communion as he did on Maundy Thursday.





Easter Sunday we will have a Easter Activities for children 5th grade and under. We will be in the childrens Sunday School room @ 9:00a.m.

#### **ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL!!**

You are invited to a genesis of our adult Sunday school class at 9:00 on Luggage. We will be using the **NOOMA Videos Series** by Rob Bell (feel free to Google him).
