We are currently scheduled to move from Lake Lotawana to Boonville on June 16. Pastor Tom is scheduled to arrive here June 27 and be in worship with you on June 28. We are hopeful all these plans will still happen.

It can be difficult to not know if our plans will come together or not. It can be stressful for some of us to not know how and what is going to happen. But, no matter what, it is comforting to know, even in the most confusing and uncertain of times, that God knows the plans he has for us. In the midst of chaos, I hope this promise bring you some peace too.
