CHERRY HILL FOOD PANTRY ~WE HAVE LOST OUR LEASE! At the Cherry Hill Food Pantry our mission is to follow Jesus' exhortation from Luke 3:10-11, "And the crowds asked him, what then shall we do?" And He answered them, "Whoever has two tunics is to share with him who has none, **and whoever has food is to do likewise.**" We have a total of 677 households currently registered as clients and continue to accept new registrants weekly. Our client base includes 555 children under the age of eighteen, 1,153 adults between the ages of 18 and 64, and 338 senior citizens. In 2018 we distributed over 520,000 pounds of food to our clients. We have a lease agreement with KIMCO for our space at the Brace Road Shopping Center that expires June 30, 2019. KIMCO does not charge us rent. We only pay expenses. We will therefore have to find a new space on our own and we will need to raise the capital necessary to pay a market rental rate.
