Happy New Years! We finally have the application for the Veteran Recognition Program ready to go. This year, we have a few updates that I will outline below. Please read them and reply to me if you have any questions. This year the application can also be filled out digitally in case you want to email me the application along with the documents.

UPDATES:

1. This year you have two options:

- Purchase new banner for \$170. The 2023 banners will have a new design, be printed on premium vinyl (higher quality than last year's), and have 6 month insurance which replaces banner in case it is destroyed due to weather.

- Rehang old banner for \$30. If you have a banner that is still in good condition, you can rehang it. NOTE that this one is not insured and will not be replaced if damaged/destroyed by weather.

2. Gold Star Veteran Banners are FREE

Banners for those who died in the recent wars (1990-present) or who have succumbed to their inner battles of those wars. If you know of a veteran, please let me know and the banner company will create a banner free of charge.

3. San Fernando Resident Scholarship Program

4. \$10 early bird discount


If you order a new banner and all documents are turned in and you approve the design of your banner before Friday, February 24, you pay \$160 for your banner.

RECREATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The San Fernando City Council established a Recreation Scholarship Program (RSP) to assist families wishing to participate in the fee base programs offered to San Fernando residents. RSP assistance is available to San Fernando residents for all recreational programs offered by the Recreation and Community Services Department, including programs for youth, adults, and seniors. Scholarships cover 50% of the cost of the activity.

To be eligible for RSP assistance you must be a resident of the City of San Fernando. Assistance will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis and starts July 1, 2022. A brief self-certifing form and a water bill must be submitted to the Department when registering for any fee base activity.


