



Interfaith Outreach Home (IOH) serves working families in financial crisis. The objective of the program is to empower families to make impactful changes resulting in permanent self-sufficiency. In order to achieve this objective, the following eligibility requirements are necessary:

- The family must consist of at least one child under the age of 16.
- The total number of family members must not exceed four (by law, our apartments can only house four individuals).
- All adults in the family must be employed full-time (40 hours per week).
- The family's income must be sufficient to meet the monthly program fee of \$150 and the mandatory monthly savings requirement of \$500.
- Written proof must be provided to show that the family is currently homeless or is about to become homeless (eviction notice, letter from a shelter, PADV, etc.).
