







Each year Christians celebrate that Jesus Christ has risen from the dead! But the world celebrates Easter with eggs and chocolate bunnies. Unfortunately, “Resurrection Sunday” has become like Christmas in that the world celebrates Santa instead of celebrating the birth of Jesus Christ.

For many Christians, joining Santa to Jesus birth and joining easter eggs and chocolate bunnies to resurrection Sunday seems harmless. The reason why is that for Christians we work hard to teach our children the difference between make-believe and the Truth. And while this is what we should do, I wonder if we also allow ourselves to think this is what others do, even if they are not Christians. After all, we reason, Christmas and Resurrection Sunday are Christian holy-days that all people should respect and at least know the basic understanding of them.

Of course, all we have to do is take a look around at our world and we will easily see that Christmas and Easter are not looked at, interpreted, understood, and celebrated the way Christians celebrate them. In fact, I would go so far as to say, that the majority of non-Christians know very little about why we celebrate Jesus’ birth and resurrection, and how foundational these two holidays are to our Christian faith. Could this be the result of assuming we know what others are thinking about the Holy-days we celebrate?

Now, I do not want to offend you in your knowledge of why we celebrate “Resurrection Sunday” but I do wonder if we are able to share the “why” with those who don’t know the why. In case you are not for sure, below is the “why.”

Celebrating Easter is about rejoicing in the risen Christ. In the days leading up to Easter, we remember His horrific death on the cross. It is a death Jesus died willingly (Mark 10:45; John 10:18). He came to earth as a baby in order to live a perfect human life and one day die as the sacrifice for sin. At Easter time, generally on Good Friday, we remember His sacrifice and thank Him for it.

But it is not only Jesus’ death on the cross that is important. Jesus’ resurrection proclaims His victory over sin and death. Jesus was crucified, died, and was buried. Then He rose back to life, proving He is who He says He is and that He accomplished what He came to earth to accomplish. Jesus Christ is fully God, fully human, and the only Savior of the world. It is because He is risen that we can trust in His sacrifice for our sins and receive new life in Him. His resurrection also demonstrates that His promise to resurrect us one day will come true.

The apostle Paul wrote, “For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, and that he appeared to Cephas, and then to the Twelve. After that, he appeared to more than five hundred of the brothers and sisters at the same time, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep. Then he appeared to James, then to all the apostles, and last of all he appeared to me also.”

1 Corinthians 15:3–8.

Easter is the time to celebrate Jesus’ victory and to celebrate the new life He gives. All can have their sins forgiven and experience new life in Him if they will receive Him by faith. Ephesians 2:1–10. The life Jesus brings is eternal. We celebrate the reality of His death and resurrection every day, and especially at Easter. Let’s make sure we do not keep the true meaning of “Resurrection Sunday” to ourselves.

Calvin called the meeting to order at 6:31 pm

Checking account balance at the end of January, 2021 was \$2,414.32

Motion was made by Janis to approve the consent calendar, and Greg seconded, motion passed.

Trustee items:

1. Easter Sunday Service will be at 7 am. The committee discussed the possibility of continuing the Easter morning tradition of a breakfast following the service.

Jennifer made a motion to hold an Easter Breakfast following the service and Dennis seconded. The motion passed.

All are invited to stay and eat, but To-Go boxes will be made up for those not able to stay.

2. Paperwork was completed with Dollar General & work to begin ASAP.

Greg shared that he is working with Dollar General with possible retention wall changes as well as options for material (dirt) to be moved from the lower church parking lot.

3. Boiler Issues in the Church building may not be an issue any more this season.

4. Remodel work at parsonage is moving forward and much is complete.

5. There appears to be drainage issues from the field south of the parsonage causing water to drain toward the house. The sump pump is constantly running. Greg has offered to do some grading work.

6. A work day will be necessary at the parsonage this spring.

New Business:
