

Lets Talk Doctrine



For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God” (Romans 3:23). This passage placed each of us in the same position with God. Adam’s sin caused every human to be born with this defect called sin. Sin is transliterated as “*hamartia*,” in the Greek, simply meaning “to miss the mark,” In archery the goal is to hit the target right in the center; we called it a bullseye or the mark. The point for us is following God’s Word which is at the

very center of the target and when we miss fulfilling God’s Word in our lives, we sin. Almost doesn’t count, we must hit the Word right in the center. Also, this should be a constant reminder of how much God loved us to send His only begotten Son to die for us. Now anger unsolved turns into hatred. This is why Paul said, “*Be angry, and do not sin*”: do not let the sun go down on your wrath, nor give place to the devil” (Ephesians 4:26-27). In our theme, Solomon reminded his son that hatred keeps the fire burning which causes strife, yet he gave him the answer by expressing, “but love covers all sins.” Peter quoted Solomon’s wisdom given to his son to inform us that the same applies to us. We can love as Jesus Christ intended us to love one another.

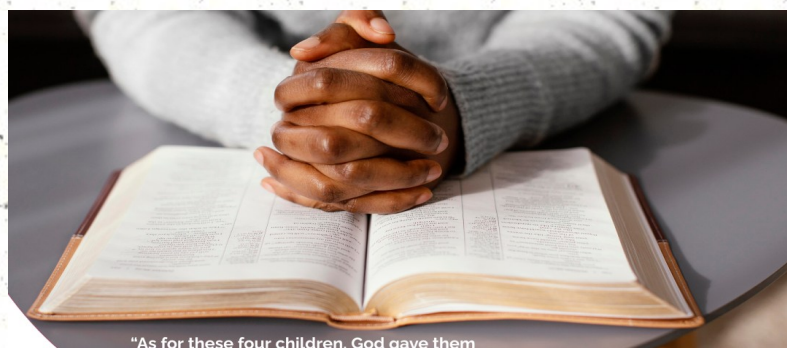

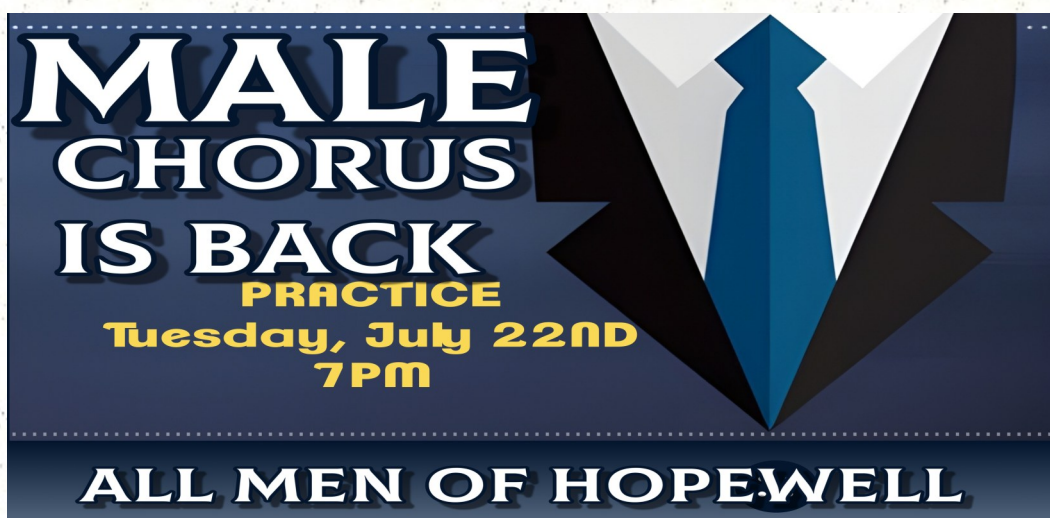
