

ne of the main themes in the Old
Testament which carries over into
the New Testament is how we
treatment one another.
September's theme focuses on why we are to
forgive one another, which allows us to be

September's theme focuses on why we are to forgive one another, which allows us to be able to love others as required by Jesus. Paul in the Book of Ephesians helps us to consider our relationships with all mankind, especially those in the household of faith. A lot of misunderstandings can be avoided, if we focus on how we talk to each other. We cannot

assume that everyone we meet are the same. What makes one person laugh; can make another person cry. The word 'corrupt' means "to rot" or "defiling speech" which tear down relationships and people who use these words to destroy rather than build up the church. Edification means literally, "to build a house." Paul uses this divine metaphor to express what God is building and that takes every member of the household of God into account. So, our words must be spoken with grace. Some of us are grieving the Holy Spirit because we defy God's will when we do not edifiy the body of Christ. The main reason for us functioning against the will of God is forgiveness. Paul states in our theme that we should always forgive because God in Christ forgave us. The word forgive means to give freely as a favor or give graciously and understanding that grace is involved, God forgave us when we didn't deserve it. Forgiveness is the beginning of the church growing in love.




