

The Twelve Disciples Matthew 10 and Luke 5

Peter: (Greek: *Petros* meaning ' Rock') – Peter was one of the most prominent of the 12 Disciples. He was a natural spokesperson and also the leader of the early Christian church. His



Original Hebrew name was Simon, a common popular Hebrew name. Jesus gave him a name '*Kephas*', an Aramaic name. John translated into it Greek '*Petros*' meaning Rock. (John 1:42 – "you will be called *Cephas*.")

Peter was a native of Bethsaida (John 1:44 New King James Version 44 Now Philip was from Bethsaida, the city of Andrew and Peter.), was the brother of Andrew and lived in a fishing town- Capernaum. Matthew 16:13-14 New King James Version **Peter Confesses Jesus as the Christ 13** When Jesus came into the region of Caesarea Philippi, He asked His disciples, saying, "Who do men say that I, the Son of Man, am?" **14** So they said, "Some *say* John the Baptist, some Elijah, and others Jeremiah or one of the prophets."

"When Jesus came to the region of Caesarea Philippi, He asked His disciples, 'Who do people say the Son of Man is?' "They replied, 'Some say John the Baptist; others say Elijah; and still others, Jeremiah or one of the prophets."" Can you believe that? Some people thought Jesus was John the Baptist or one of the old prophets coming back to life.

Matthew 16:15-16 New King James Version 15 He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" 16 Simon Peter answered and said, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

"But what about you?" He asked. 'Who do you say I am?' Simon Peter answered, 'You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God."" Why did Jesus ask His disciples who they thought He was?

Jesus didn't want His disciples to just listen to what other people said about Him. Jesus knows that we all have to decide who we think Jesus is for ourselves. We can't come to church and be Christians just because our parents or grandparents want us to. And we can't believe in Jesus just because other people believe in Him. We have to believe in Jesus because we want to believe in Jesus for ourselves.

Jesus said that He would build His church on the rock.

Peter and His belief that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God. That's the most important thing we have to believe about Jesus: that He's God's Son and that He came to save us. That's the first thing and the most important thing that the church has to believe, so that goes on the bottom and holds the rest of the church up. So, remember, you have to decide to believe in Jesus for yourself and not just listen to what other people say about Him or believe in Him because other people do. And the most important thing to believe is that Jesus is God's Son and that He came to save us.
