

He currently pastors Gethsemane United Methodist Church in the heart of Capitol Heights, MD.

A native of Columbus, Ohio, Reverend Triplett holds a Bachelor of Arts Degree from Morehouse College, and a Master of Divinity from Howard University.

There is a love for God and God's people that rests within the heart of this man. The Lord has equipped Reverend Triplett with a word in season for God's people. His sincere desire is to see the saints of God excel to heights unknown in Christ.




New Testament Lesson: Mark 1:9-15 Common English Bible (CEB)

- ⁹ About that time, Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee, and John baptized him in the Jordan River. ¹⁰ While he was coming up out of the water, Jesus saw heaven splitting open and the Spirit, like a dove, coming down on him. ¹¹ And there was a voice from heaven: "You are my Son, whom I dearly love; in you I find happiness."
- ¹² At once the Spirit forced Jesus out into the wilderness. ¹³ He was in the wilderness for forty days, tempted by Satan. He was among the wild animals, and the angels took care of him.
- ¹⁴ After John was arrested, Jesus came into Galilee announcing God's good news, ¹⁵ saying, "Now is the time! Here comes God's kingdom! Change your hearts and lives, and trust this good news!"

CELEBRATING AFRICAN AMERICAN HISTORY

Frederick Douglass



Frederick Douglass (was born Frederick Augustus Washington Bailey in 1818 and died at 77 years of age in 1895). He was a former slave who became one of the great American anti-slavery leaders (abolitionist) of the 1800s.

Frederick Douglass was born into slavery in Easton, Maryland; but in 1838, at age 20, he escaped to freedom in New York. A few years later he went to work for abolitionist William Lloyd Garrison, travelling and speaking on behalf of Garrison's paper *The Liberator*. Douglass published his memoir *Narrative of the Life of Frederick Douglass, an American Slave* in 1845. Eloquent, smart and determined, Douglass gained fame as a speaker, began his own anti-slavery publications and became a 'conductor' on the Underground Railroad.

In later years he became a personal friend of Abraham Lincoln and helped persuade Lincoln to issue the Emancipation Proclamation. He also was a strong supporter of women's rights. Douglass is often described as the founder of the American civil rights movement.

He is renowned as a social reformer, an abolitionist, an orator, a writer, and a statesman. He authored the following books: *Narrative of the Life of Frederick Douglass, An American Slave; My Bondage and My Freedom; and the Life and Times of Frederick Douglass.* His historic home is in Anacostia in Southeast Washington, DC. Additional information about Frederick Douglass is in the National Museum of African American History and Culture in Washington, DC.
