The Sphere: An Overview of the Psyche Presented by: Nard Michals, LCSW, Jungian Analyst

This seminar features an overview of the psyche through the universal image of the sphere. The sphere, as an archetypal image, helps to facilitate a deeper understanding of the psyche because it introduces perspective and dynamisms, or movement in the moment. Using relevant material from Jungian analyst and author Edward Edinger, the presentation explores the meaning of the ego and its relationship to the objective psyche.

- 1. Define and differentiate the terms "ego" and "ego strength."
- 2. Describe the basic structure of the psyche as discovered by C.G. Jung.
- 3. Explain how the psyche has a basic energic quality manifesting in the moment.
