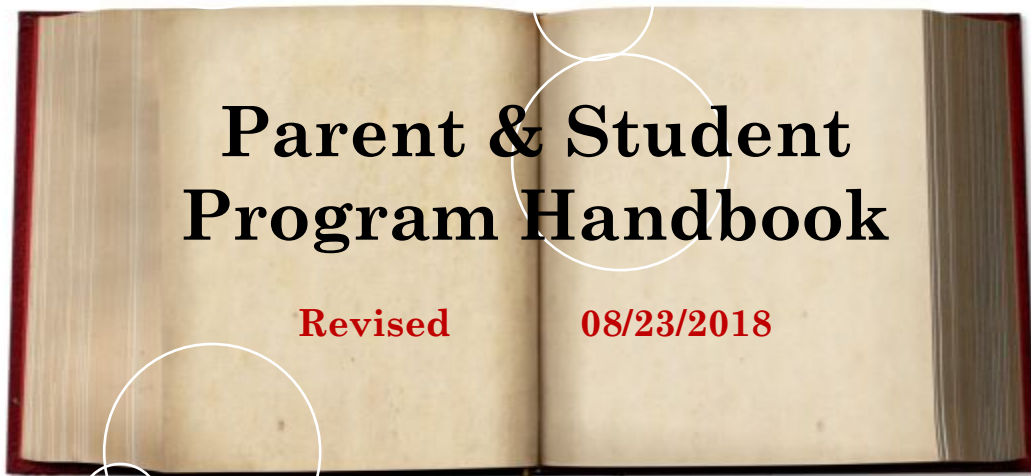

REGISTRATION FEE: \$45 non-refundable (per child)-Due at Registration

ACTIVITY FEE: \$85.00 (per child) **Must be paid by May 30, 2019**

WEEKLY FEE: \$70/ week per child **Due by—May 30, 2019**

GOALS & OBJECTIVES:

The main goal of the program is to implement hands-on teaching skills, which will bring about the desired changes in behavior and attitude of the participants through the concept of accountability, efficiency and personal change of behavior. The program plans to foster this behavior through EDUCATING, ENLIGHTENING, AND ENHANCING. The program stimulates students' social, physical, and intellectual abilities through participation with their school peers.

REGISTRATION & ENROLLMENT:

Each year Kingdom Kids Preparatory School will continue to offer the Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion program, provided the minimum number of students register, and a sufficient number of instructors are available. **Parents must complete and sign a registration form every year.** After the initial open enrollment period, registration will be ended unless the program can adequately serve additional students. If classes are full, parents may have their children placed on a waiting list. Parents will be notified when/if space becomes available.

Children who are enrolled in the Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion program, but are removed from the program for any reason (voluntary, disciplinary, late fee payment, etc.); will not be guaranteed re-enrollment in the program and no refunds will be given.

BUILDING ENTRANCE:

All students will enter the building on the Hunter Street side of the Beulah Grove Building of Opportunity between the hours of 6:00 am and 8:30 am. Each student must be signed in at drop off and signed out at pick up. **Please do not drop kids off at the front entrance.**

ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE: (Please read Release of Children on page 10)

If your child/children are dropped off after 8:30am students **must be** accompanied to the third floor and the Administrator or their designee will escort the child to their perspective class.

The program ends at 5:00 pm and students can be picked up from the banquet hall. No child will be allowed to exit the building alone. To pick up your child/children enter the building using the Hunter Street entrance of the Building of Opportunity.

TUITION:

REGISTRATION FEE: \$45 non-refundable (per child)

ACTIVITY FEE: \$85 non-refundable (per child)

WEEKLY FEE: \$70/ week per child

****Week one and activity fees are due by May 30, 2019****

Tuition payment of \$ 70.00 per week is paid on a weekly, bi-weekly, monthly, or in full basis. **Parents must pay the \$ 70.00 per week fee by the Thursday before the week of participation.** If the program is closed on Thursday, payment will be due on the date designated by Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion Administration. Tuition is paid by cash, debit, credit and/or money order.

Please note there will be NO REFUNDS.

Space is limited and parents are encouraged to apply early in order to secure a slot for your child. **The first week's tuition and registration fee is due at the time of registration.**

No Checks are accepted

Payments can be made with: cash, money orders, debit, or credit cards

No refunds of any kind will be given. This rule applies whether tuition is paid in full or weekly. No exceptions.

TUITION SCHEDULE:

Tuition is due on Thursday of each week. **Your child/children will not be allowed to attend classes or activities if tuition is not received by the due date.**

Registration fee is due at submission of paperwork, activity fee and first week's tuition is due by May 30, 2019 in full. The registration fee will not reserve or hold any classroom slots. **No refunds** of any kind will be given.

If your child/children will not be attending the entire program (For example: only weeks 3 & 5), **Full** payment for the weeks attending must be paid upon registration. *Any changes to this policy must be made a minimum 5 days prior to the scheduled week of attendance.* **No Refunds** will be given.

No Refunds will be given if your child has been dismissed from the program due to behavioral problems. Please review the disciplinary policy. No Refunds of any kind will be given.

LATE PAYMENTS OF TUITION:

Payments are due by 6:00 p.m. on Thursday for the upcoming week. Failure to pay by this time will result in a \$10.00 late fee will be added to the student’s account. The **\$10.00 late fee** will be assessed to all accounts paid after 6:00 p.m. on Thursdays.

If a parent has any outstanding financial obligations to the Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion Program that is not satisfactorily cleared within a 2-day period, the child/children will not be allowed to continue to participate in the program until the obligation is completely resolved.

LATE PICK UP FEES:

All students must be picked up by 6:00 pm. A \$1.00 per minute fee will be assessed starting at 6:01 pm. All late fees will be attached to your bill and if not paid within three (3) days the student will not be allowed to return to the program until account is cleared through payment by the Accounting Clerk..

RETURNED CHECKS: (No Checks are Accepted)

A returned check will result in a **\$35.00** fee in addition to the **\$10.00** late fee. This payment should be made with a money order or a cashier's check. No other fees should be included with this payment. It is the parent's responsibility when picking up a returned check to let the accountant know you are clearing up the outstanding tuition along with assessed fees.

If a second check is returned during the program, no more tuition payments will be accepted by check. A cashier's check or money order will be the acceptable methods of payment. If a parent has any outstanding financial obligation to the Summer Explosion Program that is not satisfactorily cleared within a 2-day period, the child will not be allowed to continue to participate in the program until the obligation is **completely** resolved.

ATTIRE:

Students may wear casual sportswear. No ripped or patched clothing, as well as any attire that is considered provocative is permitted. For safety reasons, **flip flops are not to be worn.**

We ask that clothes be appropriate and in good taste (no sexually provocative clothing, no profanity, or racial slurs, including T-shirts or clothing containing unwanted information.) Please keep in mind that this is a family camp.

TRANSPORTATION:

Transportation to and from the program is the responsibility of the parents, and they are reminded to pick up their children by 6:00 pm each day.

RELEASE OF CHILDREN:

At the end of the day children will be released **only** to persons who are authorized to pick them up as indicated on the registration form. If someone other than the authorized persons listed on the application will pick up a child, **prior written permission** is required stating the name and telephone number of the person who will pick up the child. Anyone picking up a child may be required to show

pictured identification. If no one comes to pick up the child from Program by 6:00 pm parents will be contacted. If parents cannot be reached, other authorized persons listed on the registration form will be called. If no one can be reached to pick up the child by 6:30 pm, Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion will call 911 for a police officer to pick up the child from the program.

Early pickup is permissible by signing out the student. All students must be signed out prior to leaving the class. **Parents are not allowed to go to the classrooms without checking in at the administrative office first.** Identification must be presented at the time of dismissal for the safety of the students. If someone other than the authorized persons will pick up a child, prior written permission is required stating the name and telephone number of the person who will pick up the child. **A child will not be released without proper identification or proper approval.** (See Appendix A)

CLASS DIVISIONS:

Students are to be divided according to appropriate grade levels and with regard to the number of participants at the program.

The following schedule is a typical day for the Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion Program. However, the schedule may vary slightly to accommodate the size of the program and the grade level of students:

FINALE/ENDING PROGRAM:

The finale for the Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion Program will be on Thursday, July 11, 2019. The program will commence at 9:00 am sharp. All parents/guest are invited to attend. The finale will be held in the dining hall of the Building of Opportunity or the Main Sanctuary.

Summer Explosion will end with a trip to a destination chosen by the administration of Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion. The trip will be taken on Friday, July 12, 2019, on charter buses, if needed. **Any child attending Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion that paid the Activity Fee in full...is automatically included in the major field trip.** A parent or guardian must attend the major field trip in order for child/ren to participate. Parents are responsible for feeding children during the trip. Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion will provide a snack for each student attending the major field trip upon return to the bus for departure from the designated field trip.

MEDICAL:

In order for medicine to be dispersed the parent/guardian of this child, must have completed and signed the medical information sheet (See Appendix B). The

Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion is in no way liable for any injuries that may occur to a student.

STUDENT ACCIDENTS OR INJURIES:

Minor injuries will be addressed by the Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion Administration or someone knowledgeable in first aid. If medical attention is needed, 911 will be called for assistance and parents will be notified immediately if 911 are called. Parents will be informed of all minor injuries, too.

BREAKFAST/LUNCH:

Breakfast and a hot lunch will be provided daily by the staff of Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion. A weekly menu will be provided; however students are permitted to bring their own lunch.

SNACKS:

Light snacks will be provided in the afternoon daily. Snack examples include:

PERSONAL ARTICLES:

Students should not bring toys, trading cards, sporting equipment, money, cell phones, valuable items or pets to the Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion. If a student brings items **neither Kingdom Kids Preparatory School, Beulah Grove, nor Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion will be responsible for lost, stolen, traded, or damage items.**

DISCIPLINE POLICY:

Regular school discipline policies are in effect for the Kingdom Kids Summer Explosion Program. However, if a student is disruptive or threatens other students in

any way, it may affect his or her future participation in the Program. Discipline problems will be handled using the following guidelines:

- 1st Offense: Administrator counsels the student
- 2nd Offense: Administrator counsels the student and notifies the parent in writing
- 3rd Offense: Administrator counsels the student, notifies the parent in writing and the student
- 4th Offense: Administrator counsels the student, notifies the parent in writing and a mandatory parent meeting must be held prior to student returning to Program.
- 5th Offense: Administrator will dismiss student from the program.

Depending on the severity of the offense, immediate dismissal from the program is a possibility. Parents will be notified immediately of this situation.
