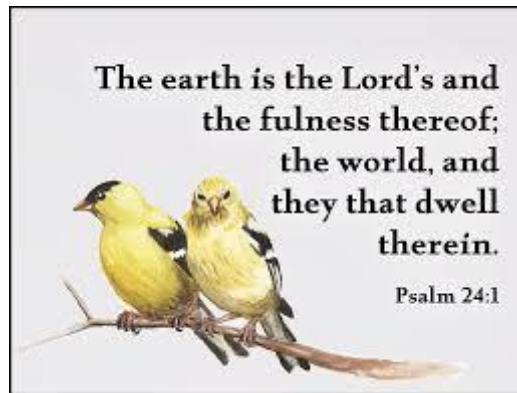

How to Share the Peace

In Romans 16:16, Paul tells members of the congregation to "greet one another with a holy kiss." Sharing the Peace is now adapted with handshakes, fist bumps, or hugs and emphasizes that believers are at peace with God and each other before receiving the Eucharist. This makes it a sacred act and not just a social greeting. The Lutheran Handbook (p. 44) suggests the following when sharing the Peace:

- **Adopt a peaceful frame of mind.**
- **Refrain from extraneous chitchat.**
- **Make appropriate eye contact.**
- **Declare the peace of God.**
