

Pastor: Upon this, your confession, I, by virtue of my office as a called and



NEW TESTAMENT: JAMES 1:12-18

Blessed is the one who endures trials, because when he has stood the test he will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love him.

¹³ No one undergoing a trial should say, "I am being tempted by God," since God is not tempted by evil, and he himself doesn't tempt anyone. ¹⁴ But each person is tempted when he is drawn away and enticed by his own evil desire. ¹⁵ Then after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin, and when sin is fully grown, it gives birth to death.

⁹ He leads the humble in what is right and teaches them his way.


¹⁰ All the LORD's ways show faithful love and truth to those who keep his covenant and decrees. (CSB)

THE HOLY GOSPEL: MARK 1:9-15

The Holy Gospel according to St. Mark, the 1st chapter.

In those days Jesus came from Nazareth in Galilee and was baptized in the Jordan by John. ¹⁰ As soon as he came up out of the water, he saw the heavens being torn open and the Spirit descending on him like a dove. ¹¹ And a voice came from heaven: "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well-pleased."

Pastor: The peace of the Lord be with you always.




