#### Baa Baa Black Sheep

After learning the rhyme, we played a math counting game. Each child was given a sheep cup holding 20 black pom poms. During each child's turn, they rolled a die and "sheared" that many pieces of wool off their black sheep.

#### Jack and Jill

After learning the rhyme and answering discussion questions, the children played a memory matching game.

#### Mary Had a Little Lamb

The children played a color/shape review game. First, they had to draw a card from the pile and identify its shape and color. They then had to move their lamb to this shape and color on the path. They repeated this process until their lamb reached Mary's school.
